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





One alledged attacker of Catro gay people is Fred Muller, who was arrested n September, 1975, after he allegedly beat a male to the ground and fractured his skull. It was learned by Gayer that this same Muller had been arrested in September, 1974 in an attack in which he allegedly used a belt and a brick. Muller is one of the several attackers who are facing possible civil actions, encouraged by the Streets Committee.

In one case in July 1975, attacker Larry Kennedy was sentenced for stabbing a male at 18th and Castro. He received a felony prosecution and is of presently serving time in a state prison. was Gayer's committee that was able to discover a good witness.

The possibility of placing a beat street patrolman in the Castro and 18th area after midnight was discussed with Mission District Captain, Rene Aufort. The officer was assigned to his new post only one week ago, after hading the command at Northern Station. He said that he has always worked cooperatively with the gay community.

Aufort revealed that he is well ware of Gayer and his committee. He had already studied Gayer's reportanalysis of beatings in the Castro area and said he would personally walk the Castro district in order to help determine the problem. Aufort said he had already placed walking patrolmen in the Mission Street (16th to 24th Sts.) and that he would consider doing the same in the Castro between Midnight and


### S.I.R.'s Watergate -WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

The major problems of the Society for Individual Rights (SIR) go much deeper than the recent embezzlement of funds by Ken Rice and Harry Leishure. This reporter served on the SIR Board for over five years but in recent times has been just as indifferent — and negligant — of being concerned about SIR as many of our readers. It is much easier to let others run the show and then move to impeach them if they do not work hard enough or make the

wrong decisions. Criticism is fun and seldom very taxing. We are just as guilt as those who try to make SIR a success for the present financial and morale crisis at SIR

So where do we go from here? We are not entirely in agreement with Duane Wolcott, a SIR Trustee who has been appointed to investigate the current problems at SIR, but some of his reasoning is stimulating and true. Over a cup of coffee at Jack-in-the-Box we recently discussed SIR's present

### Brother Bizarre's Gaze

Eyes If SB-1 wasn't such a serious issue,

by Mark Joplin it'd make a great movie. Panic in the

World of Tomorrow! Visit the terrifying world of 1977, where the truth is a Crime! You must see . . . SB-1, starring Richard Nixon, John Mitchell and Gerald Ford in their greatest roles ever!, and so on. And then, at the end of the picture, they come up with something to protect National Security - Called Big Brother. Neat, huh?

However, we shall have to put away the fictional aspects of the issue until after we have dealt with the frightening reality that is called SB-1. which would make the truth a crime, and which would put Nixon back in the limelight, and which would effectively revoke the First Ammendment, and which could ultimately lead us into the Age of Big Brother — a few years soons than anticipated. I'll tell you about it.

SB-1 is a 799 page document, first seen as HR 6046 and SB 1400, and known as the "Criminal Code Reform Bill of 1973," drafted at the direction of the Nixon White House. The two bills were merged, and the resulting product was called SB-1.

The system advocated by SB-1 is the authoritarian system that Nixon so long dreamed of; one in which he could commit the most henious acts against his country and still be held blameless. Through "National Security" and "Executive Privilege," he could conduct illegal wars, espionage, sabotage, secret dossiers on "undesirables" (read: "enemies of the President") and other high crimes, all of which would be safe from public knowledge through the simple application of a "Classified"

To give you an indication of the magnitude of crimes which SB-1 would legalize: if SB-1 were the law prior to Watergate, the break-in and bugging of Democratic National HQ, the subsequent cover-up, the illegal wat in Cambodia, Nixon's active part in the whole affair - all of this would have been legal, and Richard Nixon would still be President!

Some of the provisions of SB-1: Freedom of Speech: under sec-

tions 1102-1103 of SB-1, "subversive (for instance, anti-government) speech" may be deemed illegal by officials, even t no criminal act results from that speech. Under present law, words are not illegal unless immediately followed by a criminal act.

Secrets: SB-1's definition of "Government property" and protection thereof goes so far as to include information. Therefore, "leaks," to the general public about illegal government operations (Pentagon Papers, CIA, FBI, etc.) are subject to prosecution, under sections 1121-1124. On the

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other hand, those conducting these Know-Who is watching You! illegal operations are protected under sections 542, 544 & 552.

Miradna: "You have the right to reads to you. These are your rights, and know them. SB-1 would take that San Francisco.] away, under section 3713.

Insanity: It is a well-known fact that a great number of crimes are committed by mentally unstable people. But according to SB-1, section 522. everyone may be held "morally blameworthy" for their conduct, by their (the government's) revertal to 19th century mores in this regard.

Demonstrations: Section 1831 of SB-1 states that if 10 or more people take part in their Constitutional right to protest and demonstrate, but if in the eyes of Government officials, pose a "threat" to someone's "interests" or "property," then the group may be prosecuted under Federal laws concerning riots (a felony). The group is also subject to prosecution if property is damaged, even if the damage is done by Government agents, which studies have shown were used by the White House during the late 60's. Under section 1111, if the group inadvertantly blocked traffic, they could be prosecuted for sabotage, another felony. And finally, these demonstrations can not be held within a mile of the President, or a "temporary residence of the President."

SB-1 also reinstates the death penalty, put Native Americans under control of the Government, places labor strikes under Federal extortion laws and allows wiretapping in the name of "National Security." And we won't even mention the anti-gay provisions embodied in the bill!

It is imperative that this threat to our liberties be totally defeated - not amended, as Senator Tunney is trying to. Legal analysts have concluded that anywhere from 1100 to 2600 different deletions are going to have to be made, before SB-1 can conform to the Bill of Rights. The Senate is not about to wade through that many amendments!

Two weeks from Saturday, on the 1st of May, there will be a march and rally in Sacramento to urge the Judiciary Committee to put an end to SB-1. I urge you all to join in. Transportation is available by calling 777-4883.



What Makes Harvey Run . . .

After listening to, and reading about, weeks of charges, countercharges, accusations, denials, etc... regarding the decision of Harvey Milk to challenge Art Agnos in the 16th Assembly District Primary, and being fully aware that Harvey Milk had just completed an exhausting, yet unsuccessful race for the Board of Supervisors, I had to wonder why in Hell the guy would want to take on another political battle - since another writer ecently stated the case for the Mayor and Art Agnos - I arrived at Milk's Castro Street Camera Shop with pen, pad, and tape recorder — the back of his shop had been turned into a very busy campaign headquarters — two phones were ringing at the same time, and five young men and a young oman were busily stuffing envelopes, etc. Harvey was happy to answer some of my questions, and here is his side of the story — this is how it went: \* \* \*

Friday: What made you decide to enter this race Harvey; what is your reason for running anyway?

Milk: There is a solid two-fold reason why I am in this race; neither is the main reason; both are to me, vital. First, I feel



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



Joe Croyle is the most secure all-around talent; he sings superbly, is certainly an attractive performer and has a fine flair for zany comedy. But Richard Herkert runs him a close second with the same qualities, while Robert Redding contributes a wicked Jane Russell takeoff and sings a lovely My Mother's Eyes. R.L. Howland is a muscular imp who plays uproariously against his physical image, and director Danova is a personable fellow who seems to snag the bulk of the tiredest material for himself and still seems to enjoy it. Mama of the act is a stunning redhead named Cassandra lively sense of comedy and generates a good deal of the energy in the show. John Palmer and Jim Raitt have little to do but do it nicely.

The music for the show is on tape, vocals sung over it, and often the music drowns out all lyric content. All the "up" songs in the show are gimmicked, which means you only remember the down ballands upon leaving. Best of the lot is I Don't Want the Night to End (but put too close to Redding's Mother's Eyes to get deserved appreciation), and the Carmen Miranda finale, which is the most creative flash of the show and needs even greater build (Danova's hat could be monstrously funny). The video segments are a good touch and work nicely (when they work at all), but again, the material is as uneven on film as onstage.

Mama's Boys has the talent and potential to become a slick, snappy risque revue that could do very well on the Vegas/Reno circuit. Right now, what should be risque is sometimes just dirty (the old "say Fuck for a shock value laugh" school), sometimes just not very funny, but Mary Lincoln and Toyota are fine examples of hitting right on target. The men are all handsome, the lady is "hot" and the talent is there. Danova is absolutely right; the act is still a baby, but it could grow into a very attractive adult with a lot more work.

### W.C. Fields and Me

There are two basic problems with W.C. Fields and Me. One is that Fields was pretty much a through-and-through bastard offscreen; the second is that the film is adapted from the book of his exmistress/secretary Carlotta Monti, and Miss Monti paints herself so nobly ("I'm just a poor little Catholic virgin thrown into the wicked milieu of Hollywood and its tawdry glitter!") that she comes across onscreen as the deadliest bore to ever lay beside greatness. Because Fields was undeniably great. A bastard he may have been, but he was a comic par exellance.

But those problems aside, Fields offers a hilarious script by Bob Merrill Peterson, who reveals a great body, a filled with Fields biting, caustic humor, including all those memorable incidents he is noted for — spiking Baby Leroy's orange juice with gin so the two year old came onto the set stinking ("Ahh, that

boy will grow up to be a mean drunk!"), chasing Nelson Eddy's fish-eating swan being thrown out of Mexico for urinating upon a government official's head, the wild lost weekends with Jack Barrymore and his drunken cronies, and Fields own constant state of drunkeness that eventually cost him everything. Fields in a rage was funnier than most comics on their best nights as he railed against Eleanor Roosevelt, income taxes, children, dogs, well-meaning friends, etc. the motivations that drove Fields like a

### Vitamin B1 -Thiamine

Thiaine and other B vitamins are known as the "nerve" vitamins, though they affect other parts of the body too. The discovery of this vitamin goes to a Dutch physician, Christiaan Eijkman. When Dr. Eijkman fed chickens

"polished" rice in 1898, they became weak and developed signs of the disease called beriberi. At this same time, the patients of a military hospital he was treating were developing the same disease as well. When he fed the hens the polishings from the rice, (which contained B-1), the symptoms disappeared. He knew that something in the germ or outer coating of the rice had cured the disease.

The need for Thiamine fluctuates depending on your condition. Taking in of sugar and other carbohydrates increases the need for thiamine; thiamine aids in the burning up of carbohydrates. A hyperactive thyroid also demands more thiamine, as does stress. Signs of deficiency of vitamin B1 are: "low blood sugar," fatigue, loss of weight, loss of appetite and later stomach and mental symptoms; tingling and pain. Also nausea, constipation, irregular heartbeat, frequent colds and headache, just to name a few.

It is useless to ingest more vitamin B1 rich foods than your body can use. Being water soluble, the vitamin is not stored in the body, but excreted.

Police investigators now reveal that they have a California "rap sheet" on Rice's earlier police record, but it remains confidential.
