to prevent it. Careful advance planning will help insure that an outing is a fun experience, unmarred by the unexpected.

The first caution is to those who have any kind of medical condition that could cause trouble, especially heart disease or chronic lung or kidney disease. These persons should not be away from medical care for long and should certainly consult with their physician before going on a hiking trip. Altitude adaptation can pose sore problems. Living at or near sea level, our bodies are set to function most efficiently at low altitude. As we move up in altitude, we have to exchange a larger volume of thinner air to get enough oxygen. Take time to adjust to high altitude and don't overexert yourself.

Observe the following pointers for a safe and enjoyable hiking trip:

There were so many booths, it would be hard to describe them all; but it was interesting to note the many openly gay booths and stands in view.





It testified before the Brother Bizarre's Gaze California State Insurance Commissioner - resulting in a new state policy of requiring non-discrimination against gay people in issuing insurance. Pride authorized a \$1,000 sum to assist a legal action to overthrow California's vague "lewd conduct" and "sexual solicitation" statutes, and protested the awarding of the Brotherhood Award to the President of Pacific Telephone by a religious

The organization is fully non-political and holds a federal tax-exemption, which it won after a legal hassle in Washington. Although Pride was unable to take a stand on the fundamentalist churches lobbying against consensual sex legislation, it did file legal briefs with the Fair Political Practices Commission. This resulted in the commission's new policy - that churches who lobby for proposed sexual legislation must register as lobbyists. If the churches register as lobbyists, it could bring into question their federal taxexempt status. This is a serious blow to the future of such fundamentalist groups as The Coalition of Christian Citizens

There are a number of individual actions that Pride performs, incidental to it's major actions - such as' its recent financial and legal assistance in a case involving a male who was refused an apartment rental on the basis that he was "queer" ... Pride officials testified before the State judicial panel which considered the appointment of John Vukasin to become an Associate Justice of the Court of Appeals. Vukasin had let it be known that he thought homosexuals were "undesirables." He was not appointed ... Pride's on-going Coalition to Defend Gays in the Military has assisted those upfront gay people who wish to

Pride has no auditorium, no dances, no monthly membership meetings, no monthly publications and no rent to pay. It directs all of its income to such matters as paying a telephone exchange fee, paying legal filing fees for its court actions, and necessary clerical expenses. 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

the Many thought to his own making, the religious threaten to become an issue, though maybe not a major one, in the coming Presidential election. Carter seems obsessed by religion, which doesn't make him a bad guy; however, the national interest in the Southern Baptist religion has come about chiefly because the candidate himself can't shut up about the fact that he has become, by his own description, a "born again" Christian.

What do Southern Baptists membership possibly influence Baptist Convention; and, although it is thought of as mainly a Southern religion, they now have over 12 million members - some in parts of the country other than the South. Like Carter, most Southern Baptists describe themselves as "born again" Christians who experienced an emotional turning point into a "new life" when they committed themselves to Christ. They consider themselves as very strict biblebelievers (and Carter says homosexuality is contrary to the teachings of the Bible) with an urgent duty to "spread the faith," as in the world-wide crusades of Southern Baptist evangelist Billy Graham, whose conversion began at a "fire and brimstone" revival at the age of

Compared with "mainline" groups such as Methodists and Southern Baptists put less emphasis on complex theologies and more on the personal relationship between the individual and God,

#### Flea Bites

Fleas are small insects which feed on animal or human blood, without which they can neither breed nor survive. Though some species are capable of transmitting disease, the principal cause for complaint in the Bay Area results from the painful itching caused by flea bites, occurring more frequently during the summer and fall months. Most of the complaints are due to the cat and dog flea, and, to a less extent, the human flea.

A concentration of bites on the lower part of the legs usually indicates the presence of fleas from a pet cat or dog in the home, and the infestation can be traced to the area of the house where the animal spends most of its time. Where there is no household pet, a sudden appearance of fleas may be due to a stray animal which had its litter under the house, in the basement or some similar place; and upon departure, its fleas are left behind to bite man. The bites of the human flea are characteristically distributed

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his contractual agreement to umpire any game goes for either one hour and a half or seven innings, whichever is shorter; and, second, city park rules prohibit city umpires to start any inning within 20 minutes of the next scheduled game. Since there was a 2 o'clock scheduled game in our league, the city umpire had no alternative other than to call the game at that point.

In both instances, the umpires, and whether they were straight or not had no bearing on the propriety of their action, acted completely within their rights and indeed within their duty.

Rennis indicated that he is disillusioned with the CSL because it is no longer any fun. I cannot help but wonder if it was any more fun last year when he continually griped about the performances of his defensive team; at one point even sitting on the mound with his head down in disgust because his second baseman had



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## B.A.R.'s 5th Anniversary


The Bay Area Reporter is five years old this year; and we would like to say thank you to all of the advertisers, writers, graphics people and everyone else who have made this possible.

On behalf of the staff, we would like to thank the Senate and the Mayor for the honor they have bestowed upon us and hope we can continue to live up to the expectations of us.







