### Yes On Prop. T (FOR FAIR REPRESENTATION)

An incredible wideranging coalition is mobilizing behind Proposition T, the November 2 ballot measure that would establish district election of supervisors. Neighborhood groups from all over the city are joining forces, and the measure also has strong support from labor and from the black Proposition T community. would drastically alter the composition of the Board of Supervisors, which is now heavily weighted with people from one upper-income enclave around St. Francis Woods - that's the same neighborhood Mayor Moscome resides in. Proposition T would create eleven districts with the first district election taking place in November 1977. The basic issue is simple: taking political power from the downtown interests and putting it back into the neighborhoods with the people where it belongs. Yes on T is being easily outspent, as expected. Opponents have raised as much in two weeks as San Franciscans for District Elections has in three months;

Not surprisingly, ten of the eleven incumbent supervisors oppose the measure. Proposition T's boundary lines appear to put many supervisors on the endangered species list. If ever the gay population of this city is to have its say in how City Hall is run, we must have representation of gay citizens, not just those who claim they care about gays, on the Board of Supervisors. The passage of Proposition T is the answer; we could easily have one, and possibly two, gay Supervisors in San Francisco if Proposition T passes. Single gays pay the highest tax rate in this city, and we deserve our say in how that tax money is spent. Proposition T is a step, and a very important one, in the right direction. Vote YES on Proposition T!

What may seem to be reasonable terms of human rights for gay persons is actually receiving unreasonable treatment by certain persons on the HRC and the Board of Education.




#### Lutherans Concerned ... FOR GAY PEOPLE

Los Angeles. Lutherans Concerned for Gay People has centralized its Steering Committee in Los Angeles and has named a Minnesota woman and a Los Angeles man as its

Lutherans Concerned, an organization of gay and non-gay Lutherans working for a climate of justice and understanding among the 8.9 million member Lutheran churches, has operated with its Steering Committee dispersed throughout the country since its founding in Minneapolis on June 17, 1974. Last January the group moved its main mailing address from Salt Lake City to Box 19114A, Los Angeles, Ca. 90019.

The centralizing decision was prompted in part by Lutherans Concerned's steady growth over the past two years, according to its newsletter, The GAY LUTHERAN. The group now has active chapters in New York City, Miami, Chicago, Michigan, Ohio, the Twin Cities, San Francisco and Los Angeles, and initial interest has been expressed in forming new chapters in several other cities.

The gay people elected coordinators by the new California-based Steering Committee were Diane Fraser, 33, of Kasota, Minn., and Howard Erickson, 38, of Los Angeles.

Stop the Suffering: We Have Just Begun . . .

May we share some personal suffering with you? At the age of 46, this columnist recalls a childhood of continued oppression and pain. Outwardly, the writer was a gregarious person involved in journalism and politics - just as we are today. However, internally, the BIG SECRET had to be kept quiet; and it was not until much later that we realized how much we had been

Shortly after his election Murphy. Tunney's biggest asset to the Senate, Tunney, who had opposed building the supersonic transport during the campaign, attended a hearing on it in Los Angeles. The testimony convinced him to change his position and favor the plane. When he returned to Washington, however, he attended some Senate hearings on the issue and once again changed his mind and decided to vote against the SST. Two other issues on which the junior California Senator has changed his mind are National Health Insurance, which Tunney first strongly supported and now opposes because he thinks it would cost too much, and de-regulation of natural gas prices, which he had originally opposed, but says he now favors.

His attandance record on the Senate floor when major legislation came up for votes leaves much to be desired. The roll-call finds bill after bill with the notation of either "absent" or "paired but not voting" after Tunney's name. He has the image problem of being a "playboy" and a "lightweight" - I don't know about his being a "playboy," but the definition of being a "lightweight Senator" fits him to the proverbial "T." Tunney's supporters would take issue with me on my definition of the Senator, and, to be honest about it, Tunney has had moderate success in getting legislation passed; over thirty bills and amendments offered by Tunney since he entered the Senate are now law. They range from minor legislation to major efforts such as the Noise Pollution Control Act, the extension of Voting Rights Act, and the Toxic Substances Control Act which, after four years of work in Congress, has been sent to the White House for President Ford's signature.

would-be zany farce involving an Italian husband escaping his brother-in-law, who wants to kill him, by hiding out in a gay baths, a la Continental in New York; and the resulting confrontations between the straight macho Italians and the swish clientele are often very funny under Richard Lester's brisk direction. There is nothing subtle or unstated in "The Ritz;" everyone in the film is a giant cliche, and the film often seems to strain too hard for laughs.

Broad slapstick is the rule of "The Ritz" and what strives be uproarious becomes labored. But it is definitely a film that has many bright, hilarious moments, mainly thanks to the superlative performances of Jack Weston as the harried Gaetano and Rita Moreno as the Puerto Rican would-be bombshell Googie Both Weston and Moreno capture perfectly the Feydeau farce quality and the sweeping caricatures that make them dominate the screen from start to finish. Moreno's entrance alone is worth the entire admission charge. Googie is a no-talent spitfire who sings downstairs in the baths waiting for Hal Prince or David Merrick to discover her, and she would kill anyone who stands in her way. Moreno fires off a broadside avalanche of one-liners and quicksilver reactions that are brilliant, creating in the process an unforgettably comic character. Weston, in contrast, manages to convincingly look perplexed and harassed for 96 minutes, while dodging in and out of disguise and fighting off an ardent chubby chaser, well played by

Paul B. Price. Jerry Stiller as the gangster brother-in-law plays predictably on one monotonous level, and Kaye Ballard makes a token appearance toward the end that garners a few guffaws. F. Murray Abraham is excellent as the flaming queen of the tubs, announcing "the orgy will begin in five minutes in room 304," and Treat Williams offers bodywatchers a field day as the straight detective with the squeaky falsetto voice. Terence McNally's play

allows no room for dimension: straights are 50's macho and gay is screaming. But the gross unfairness applies all the way down the line, so you can only go with it and enjoy the farcical aspect of "The Ritz" and not expect anything but stereotypes. It is strictly a visual romp; and, as such, it is often hilarious. Enjoy it for what it is, an old farce updated to a modern locale, and don't make demands. 

### At The Sound Of The Bell (COLUMBIA)

meant to be reviewed in this column, it is Pavlov's Dog's AT THE SOUND OF THE BELL.
