MIAMI, FLA. - Millionairess Anita Bryant says she will fight a Gay rights ordinance even "if my livelihood is stripped away from me."

"I will not be moved,"

Bryant said in an interview on Tuesday.

"I'd rather have the love of God and be making this a better place to live for my children and other children."

She has helped organize a group called "Save Our Children Inc." because she believes the local Gay community is "trying to recruit our children to homosexuality."

Gay rights leaders call her efforts "bigoted" and "fanatical." They have tried, unsuccessfully, to pressure the Florida Citrus Commission, for which she has advertised orange juice since 1968, into taking her ads off the air.

Bryant, 37 and mother of four, was Miss Oklahoma in 1959 and was second runner-up in that wear's Miss.

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



Anyone who has ever been convicted of a sex offense must register and reregister for a lifetime with the local police as a "sex offender." Gay prisoners have yet to receive equality in state institutions. You may still be arrested for asking someone to have sex with someone to have sex with you. We still need our political friends to right

these wrongs.

The local Gay press currently numbers seven publications. The major ones appear every two weeks; the rest make the rounds once a month. All

weeks; the rest make the rounds once a month. All share one thing: they cost the reader nothing but his time (in some cases, worth more than what he is invited to spend). Also available in the eye-sore street corner boxes are the national publications, the ADVOCATE and L.A.'s NEWSWEST. For a small city, this bounty is nothing short of remarkable.

With Gay people estimated at one-fifth of S.F.'s population, the significance and impact of the Gay press has not been lost on the major media. On the whole, Gays are literate, affluent, and "au courant." The last untapped minority market. Generally speaking, Gays spend what they have or earn on the NOW. Life insurance, annuities, trust funds, legacies don't siphon off their dollars as they do the average family man. I've never met a Gay who purchased a cemetery plot, and know of few setting aside funds for their sunset years. Our "rainy days" are usually today.

are usually today.

Increasingly, Gay dollars are the target of anybody with anything to huckster.

In conjunction with the ready cash of the Gay

market is the loyalty of the Gay consumer to the Gay businessman. This is not to say the Gay operation offers a better product, delivers a better service or is more reliable. Yet, when was the last time any of us had anyone but a Gay person work on our hair. Or what one of us would do business with an obnoxious homophobe.

The affinity is real - and the more alert corporations in S.F. are courting (albeit stealthily) the Gay consumer. A case in point is the major S.F.

Like them or detest them, there is no doubt in our minds that the establishment editors and journalists receive and study the Gay publications. And not only here – from the N.Y. TIMES to the wooth is sizable public and claim them as their own. Most discretely, of course.

One of the axioms of social philosopher Herbert Marcuse is that sooner or later the mainstream, the establishment, co-ops the revolutionary, the radical programs and projects. It absorbs them into an ample bosom, smothering them, defusing them, defanging them. If this theorem holds true, the Gay press will eventually be swallowed by the middle-brow giants.

The Sexual Outlaw

by John Rechy (Grove Press)

Last week brought to the editor's desk the latest wrinkle in book promotion (at least in our experience). Grove Press sent a ready-made review plus selected chapters from the book (an uncorrected proof no less) assembled in a 39-page pamphlet. The do-it-yourself review of Rechy's forthcoming work written forthcoming work written by the Grove staff glows (naturally). The piece-of-book serves as some sort

of literary aperitif.

Together they supply an easier, quicker way for the overworked book editor. With a promise that THE SEXUAL OUTLAW will head Grove's Spring list of books, there are advantages of getting are advantages of getting on board the bandwagon before the parade begins. Unfortunately, Grove's taste of honey doesn't amount to very much ... and how does one react to bits and snippets of a hoped-for major literary event. Perhaps with bits and snippets - trading bite-size for bite-size.

Grove's Kent Carrol refers to THE SEXUAL OUTLAW as "a passionate outcry against the oppression of homosexuals." Rechy's claim is more modest, "a non-fiction account with commenaccount, with commen-taries, of three days and nights in the sexual under-ground."

We learn THE SEXUAL OUTLAW is "set in the parks, alleys, tunnels, garages, streets and beaches of contemporary Los Angeles and its immediate environs."
Familiar turf for Rechy, and with his penchant for elaborate elaboration, perhaps an over-trod turf by now.

From the tidbits on hand, it appears Rechy is determined to romanticize his "sexual outlaws" out of the subterranean ... or worse, to immortalize the male hustler into American folklore. Or is he re-picking overly-picked bones - it's hard to tell with one-sixtieth of a book. One does have

suspicions though.

For the San Franciscan, "an excursion of a sub culture of our cities still hidden from our view," and to show what "it's really like in the Gay underworld" is somewhat of a dead horse. In 1977 it's hardly "explosive subject matter."

Grove Press also touts Rechy as "widely regarded as the most important American author to creatively unveil the realm of homosexuality in this country." A bit of a blow job, one suspects. If I can trust my swiss-cheese memory, I found Rechy's "explosive" CITY OF NIGHT boring. His subsequent NUMBERS

doubly boring.



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
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


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
