AGNOS: AB 1302 NEEDS HELP

Assembly Unit OK's Gay Bill **AGNOS MOVES AB 1302 OUT OF COMMITTEE**

SACRAMENTO - Assemblyman Art Agnos (Dem - SF), sponsor of AB 1302 which would protect Gay people against discrimination in employment, saw his measure approved by the Labor, Employment and Consumer Affairs Committee late last week.

The bill was approved by a 7-to-2 vote after a long hearing, which the chairman said had turned into "a legislative Gong Show."

Assemblyman Bill Lockyer (Dem - San Leandro) made the remark after an opponent of the bill said facetiously his sexual preference was for an "adult male crocodile."

Agnos said the measure would give homosexuals
"the right to make a living in peace."

Several Gay men, including a teacher, a lawyer, and a warehouse worker, testified in favor of the measure. Each listed his name but declined to name his employee.


The measure would also prohibit discrimination against workers who refuse to grant sexual favors to their boss, a customer or fellow employee.

Agnos said the section would dissuade "persons

in power from using sex as a weapon."

The most controversial section of the bill would outlaw employment discrimination based on the "existence or manifestation of asexuality or of a sexual preference."

Agnos put over for a later hearing a second, more far-reaching bill that would make it unlawful to discriminate in employment against homosexuals.



Said one opponent at a committee hearing on AB 1302, the bill "puts society's stamp of approval on homosexual acts" and discourages homosexuals from changing their lives.

Freshman Assemblyman Agnos (who defeated local Gay activist Harvey Milk last June in the Democratic Primary and won easily in November) has been fulfilling his cambeen fulfilling his campaign promise to advance Gay rights. He now feels

the Gay community has to back up his efforts with letters and phone calls to State legislators.

"The major objection that must be countered (thanks to Bryant) is that Gays are bad role models and molest children," said Agnos. Agnos.

AB 1302 (the measure to be more strenuously pushed this session) expands the definition of sex in the existing code, giving it contemporary understanding, a broader base.

At present it is illegal to discriminate in employment because of one's sex. AB 1302 will attempt to be more specific. It will be illegal to discriminate because of gender (physiological characteristics). Secondly, illegal to discriminate if an employee refuses to grant sexual favors (i.e. denied promotion or fired). Thirdly, illegal to discriminate because of sexual preference, or even asexuality.

Michael Writes **To His Parents**

DEAR MAMA,

I'm sorry it's taken me so long to write. Every time I try to write to you and Papa I realize I'm not saying the things that are in my heart. That would be OK, if I loved you any less than I do, but you are still my parents and I am still your child.

I have friends who think I'm foolish to write this letter. I hope they're wrong. I hope their

parents who loved and trusted them less than mine do. I hope especially that you'll see this as an act of love on my part, a sign of my continuing need to share my life with you.

I wouldn't have written, I guess, if you hadn't told me about your involvement in the Save Our Children campaign. That, more

than anything, made it clear that my responsibility was to tell you the truth, that your own child is homosexual - and that I never needed saving from anything except the cruel and ignorant piety of people like Anita Bryant.

I'm sorry, Mama. Not for what I am, but for how you must feel at this moment. I know what that feeling is, for I felt it for most of my life. Revulsion, shame, disbelief - rejection through fear of something I knew, even as a child, was as basic to my nature as the color of my eyes.

No, Mama, I wasn't "recruited." No seasoned homosexual ever served as my mentor. But, you know what? I wish someone had. I wish someone older than me and wiser than the people in Tallahassee had taken me aside and said, "You're all right, kid. You can grow up to be a doctor or a teacher just like anyone else. You're not crazy or sick or evil. You can succeed and be happy and find peace with friends - all kinds of friends who don't give a damn who you go to bed with. right away. It's enough for me to know that I no Most of all, though, you can love and be loved, longer have to lie to the people who taught me to without hating vourself for it."

But no one ever said that to me, Mama. I had to find it out on my own, with the help of this beautiful city that has become my home. I know this may be hard for you to believe, but San Francisco is full of men and women, both straight and gay, who ignore sexuality in considering the worth of another human.

These aren't radicals or weirdos, Mama. They are shop clerks and bankers and little old ladies and people who nod and smile to you when you meet them on the bus. Their attitude is neither patronizing nor pitying. Their message is evident. Yes, you are a person. Yes, I like you. Yes, it's OK

I know what you must be thinking now. You're asking yourself: What did we do wrong? How did we let this happen? Which one of us made him that way?

I can't answer that, Mama. In the long run, I guess I really don't care. All I know is this: If you and Papa are responsible for the way I am, then I thank you with all my heart, for it's the light and the joy of my life.

I know I can't tell you what it is to be gay. But I can tell you what it's not.

It's not hiding behind words, Mama - like family and decency and Christianity. It's not fearing your body, or the pleasures that God made for it. It's not judging your neighbor, except when he's crass or unkind. It's not being legal, moral or acceptable - but liking yourself just the same.

Being gay has taught me tolerance, compassion and humility. It has shown me the limitless possibilities of living. It has given me people whose passion and kindness and sensitivity have provided a constant source of strength.

It has brought me into the family of man, Mama, and I like it here. I like it.

The charges against the officer in this case were sustained according to a letter signed by Lt. Ronald Utz, and the officer was to be "counselled" regarding his behavior. The letter also contains the typed signature of Chief MacNamara, but the Chief denied any knowledge of the case, saying that it hadn't been brought to his attention. There are numerous questions about the so-called "counselling" in this case that have yet to be answered.

On the entrapment/harassment issue, the police still maintain that there is no entrapment. They have agreed to a second meeting, however, to listen to the various entrapment/arrest tapes in possession of the Gay Task Force.

A lighter moment occurred when Lt. Utz insisted that the Vice Unit was arresting Gays in the St. James area because there had been complaints from senior citizens about "homosexual activity." In response to this, one of the attendees observed, "I find it hard to believe that Gay people would be soliciting senior citizens." It was determined that these alleged "complaints" had been made during the daytime when Gay cruising is minimal.

The police brass had no answer for the statistics indicating a drastic increase in 647(a) arrests. They conceded that similar arrests are not being made in public places where heterosexuals would be likely to "solicit" for sexual purposes other than prostitution. Nor would they make any commitments regarding the current Vice Unit harassment other than to say they will consider individual charges in specific cases.

Lucky Guerrero called for the dismissal or

Lucky Guerrero called for the dismissal or transfer of Sgt. Louis Hernandez from the Vice Unit, stating that Hernandez is an instigator of the current harassment of Gays. The police avoided a discussion of the request. Recently, one of the 647(a) arrestees has filed an extensive complaint

naming several officers including Sgt. Hernandez charging unofficerlike conduct. The City Ombudsman's Office is handling the investigation at present. To the Gay activists the meeting was useful; it demonstrated to the police the growing alarm in both the Gay and straight communities and that police excesses will be documented. The second meeting (with tapes and documentation) will determine Chief MacNamara's accountability for the action of his officers. action of his officers.

In a related development, the D.A.'s office dropped charges in another 647(a) case because of "insufficient evidence" when, in reality, they had no case and the person never should have been arrested in the first place. This individual went through torment and had legal expenses totalling \$800.
