

#### LESBIAN NAMED TO MUNICIPAL COURT BENCH MARY C. MORGAN GAINS LANDMARK POST IN SF

Governor Jerry Brown has named San Francisco attorney Mary C. Morgan to the Municipal Court. Ms. Morgan is a graduate of New York University Law School and has been practicing law since 1973. Ms. Morgan was born 35 years ago in New Orleans, Louisiana. Her appointment did not come as any real suprprise but it was long overdue many activists felt. She was supported for the Bench by a host of organizations and individuals, including, Congressman John L. Burton, the Harvey Milk Gay Democratic Club, Police Commissioner Jane McKaskle Murphy, the Stonewall Gay Democratic Club, Robin Tyler, Mary Vail, Dr. Tim Wolfred a member of the Community College Board, the National Conference of Black Lawyers, Judge Stephen Lachs of the Municipal Court in Los Angeles, Ms. Priscilla Alexander, and the Barbary Coast Democratic Club, to mention but a few of her many supporters.

Judge Morgan stated that,, "I am extremely honored and thrilled to have been appointed to the San Francisco Municipal Court. It is a momentous event not only for me but the entire lesbian and gay community here and throughout the State." The staff of Gay California Focus Magazine wishes Municipal Court Judge Mary C. #### SOUTHERN ILLINOIS COAL MINE VIOLENCE

GALATIA, Ill., Aug. 18-Two thousand union miners showed up at the non-uion mines being built here in this southern Illinois town, to protest the Kerr-McGee Company opening of a mine here with non-union labor. The company responded by calling in State Police and the National Guard, and then armed thugs of Kerr-McGee attacked the demonstrators and the Police and Guard took after the pickets with billy-clubs and dogs, and ended the melee with tear gas. The protestors then began tearing down the two miles of fencing put up by the scab-labor thugs of Kerr-McGee. The union vows a fight to the finish.


#### ANTI-GAY COP APPEARS TO BE GETTING AWAY WITH BREAKING THE LAWS

Inspector William C. Bigarani, 49, who was for some years, a terror on the homosexual community in the city with his entrapment of gays in rest rooms and parks and was nicknamed "Bigaweenie," for his disgusting efforts by his fellow officers, and was given a three year probation for grand theft, now appears to be about to go back to work full time as a cop. The Police Commission consisting of Lesbian Jo Daley, supported his being allowed during his trial to work as a cop, and now his lawyers are seeking to have him returned to full time duty back on the streets. Bigarani was ordered by the Court, to pay restitution of \$24,730 and to perform 100 hours of community service and the grand-theft charge was reduced to a misdemeanor.

He is currently an acting lieutenant and if allowed to either go back or even retire, he will get quite a large pension. Bigarani once ran for Sheriff with the nickname "The Enforcer" another of his names gathered in his brutal way of enforcing the law. He ran a one-man war against the Beatniks of upper Grant Avenue twenty years ago, tearing up poetry, and even arresting a young woman for going barefooted and arresting a "beat-nik poet for "swearing." MORMON-OWNED AMUSEMENT PARK WELCOMES GAYS A "LANDMARK" EVENT FOR LESBIAN & GAY PEOPLES

Two years ago a southern California disco owner tried a "gay night" at the Marriott's Great America near San Jose. It was less than a success for too many reasons. And as a result of the poorly organized event. Marriott's said that they didn't want gays back.

But now, two years later, thanks to the man who wouldn't take no for an answer, Aryae Levy, there will be a Gay Night At Marriott's Great America on Saturday October 10th. From 3 pm til 8 pm it will be a general mix-in with straights and then from 8 til 11 pm the park goes exclusively Lesbian and Gay men. At 8 pm, all people who are not wearing one of the Gay Night buttons will be cleared from the park and then it will be non-stop til closing Gay Night for sure. The Gay Men's Chorus will sing; Robin Tyler will be doing one of her excellent comedy routines; and the Foggy City Squares will give an exihibition. David Kelsy and Pure Trash will perform

on stage as well. Aryae's Great Outdoors Adventures, the sponsoring group has worked long and hard to make this Gay Night a successful one, and it has almost unanimous backing from the Lesbian and Gay communities.

There will be buses from various bars here in the city to Marriott's, and as

well, groups are planning special buses. Aryae Levy's Great Outdoors Adventures was founded in May of '79 and has grown steadily, giving the gay community an alternative to city life with their field trips such as skiing, camping trips, whitewater rafting, hot-air ballooning, house-boating as well as his West Indies Windjammer Cruise and his Christmas in Mexico vacation trips.

There are well over 1000 members now.



We here at Gay Focus know that God loves each and everyone equal regardless of a Rev. Jerry Falwell!



In a dark alley in a large American city, some years back, a small ragged boy was found. Seemed to be about 14 and his face haggared. The cold air off the river had no pity, as it pierced his ragged clothes. The boy had once a happy home. His parents cast him out as he was "different," it seems. And he left, with no funds, nor any friends in the big city he arrived in. He faced this hard society with but a few dimes in his pocket, and tried to earn his living by selling the Star-Times. This day, the day he was found was one in which everything seemed to go wrong, and in his despair he lay down in the dark alley. A few newsboys gathered around him, and was asked in a kind way, "Say Tommy when don't around him, and was asked in a kind way, "Say, Tommy, why don't you go to the room?" But the lad could but murmmur, that he could not move, and told the others that, "I am dying.....yes, I am dying, for I can feel it, I feel so strange.....I can hardly see you fellas." "I see, yes I see angels, they are holding out their hands for me....see them fellas, see them?" I going fellas, I am truly going .... good by e guys ... I.m going to begin life anew now, I see it all ... and pehaps I'll meet some of the other fellas there too ... I .......!" With few words having fallen from his lips, his head slumped to the ground again, the cold damp ground, in an alley, near the riverfront in that cold December day of 1948. The next morning, a passerby saw a sight that would soften the most hardened heart. There, lying on the cold ice covered ground, with his body huddled against the brick build ing, and his eyes staring upwards towards the heavens, was the poor frozen form of the 14 year young newsboy. He took the lifeless body to a church nearby and there the minister took the body of the dead newsboy to have him interred by kind hands. And those who attended church that day will never forget the poor frozen boy's funeral attended only by those regular church goers none of whom even knew the lad. He was missed only by his few regular paper customers whom quickly forget the lad. But it was an event that had a marked place on my life. And even today when I see many, some blow the rest away. younger, some older, going about the streets of the Tenderloin, not really wanted by anyone, and they not wanting anything, lives, that live for naught. Ships that pass in the night....I care. Do you care about those less fortunate? Have your shared a meal with someone less fortunate? Do you care about others? or do you just care for yourself and the pleasures you seek? If so.

Through the years, mankind has suffered greatly at one time or another from those who chose to call themselves "vigilantes." Vigilantes are those who gather to enforce the law as they see if when the law no longer is doing what the vigilantes feel it should be do-

But, as beauty is in the eye of the beholder, so is the vigilantes view of the law and the out-law. Laws were not made to be broken but to

be aguideline to protect those who might be oppressed by those who would call themselves "vigilantes."

The KKK (Klu Klux Klan) was began as a vigilante-group to "protect" whomever they felt should be protected and to punish all who disgreed with them or who were "different."

Certainly their hasseling of Gay hustlers on Polk Street is applauded by the vile Polk Street merchants who like the "vigilantes," but it is none of the vigilantes business if a person is hustling or not on Polk and their harassment of Gays on Polk must cease. Polk, Broadway, Fisherman's Wharf, and the Finacial district do not need or want the obviously media-hungry "guardian angel vigilantes" who while tainned in our city and almost all appear to be from him, are operated from New York City by some young character who "loves Ronald Reagan," whom most of us know to be our enemy, a broderline fascist. Their funding is dubious, their goals outside of getting media-attention, are also quite questionable.

And while such conservatives and right-wingers as a Lee Dolson, and the San Francisco Progress newspaper praise them, those who fear the fragile liberties we still have, can see in these latter day vigilantes, something very ominous. Fascism is on the rise in the U.S. and it uses "law and order," the "good old days" and such slogans to herald their fascist oppression. 

### BONZO' REAGAN WIELDS HIS AXE FOCUS OPINION REAGANOMICS or: BONZO REAGAN WEILDS THE AXE!" by Ed Dollak '81

Some analysts predict that short-term cash problems could interrupt Social Security payments by next year. While actual bankruptcy is unlikely, cuts by budget slashers threaten to undermine benefits. Social Security is in peril.

The fund is in danger despite huge payments by workers. "Today, more than half of all American families pay more in payroll taxes than they do in income taxes."....(Newsweek, June 1, 1981)

Problems with Social Security appeared as early as 1975, but the difficulties did not come from exorbitant benefits nor even primarily from an increased ratio of beneficiar-ies to workers. The factors that spelled trouble were the same ones that brought crisis to the economy as a whole.

High unemployment cut deeply into revenues, because people who are not working do not pay FICA withholding taxes. At the same time, record high inflation, increased benefits tied to the Consumer Price Index. The fund decreased and in '77 payroll taxes went up to recover the difference. Further rate hikes are scheduled through 1990, beleagan's claims that he is cutting taxes.

To make matters worse, many employers began to dump middle-aged workers to take advantage of high unemployment rates amongst youth. Older workers thrown out the door have no alternatives but early retirement, placing a further drain on Social Security trust funds.

"Bonzo" Reagan and his "axe" men wail about the crisis in Social Security as justifi cation for their benefit cuts; but they hide the real nature of that "crisis" and try to shift the blame. They ignore the overall economic dilemma of ugly capitalism, if you will, which jeopardizes Social Security and every other hard-won cushion standing between workers and deprivation.

Government statisticians have figured out that people live longer now. The reaction airies' solution is to raise the retirement age so that is is closer to the time when most people die. For older persons, that would virtually wipe out the advances of medical cience and confront them with a familiar grim wager: will they live long enough to enjoy their well-deserved rest.

joy their well-deserved rest. Or will the boss use up every ounce of life strength to line his own pockets? In spite of longer lifespans, the tend today is toward early retirement and the choice is usually not made for convenience or luxury. People must have the option to retire at age 62 or even earlier--because of the uncertainty of the economy and the increasing risk of disa-bility. Workers certainly do not retire early to bask in wealth provided by Social Securi-ty. Average benefits provide about \$2,700 per year for an individual n \$5,500 per coup-le. These are paltry sums, if one is to keep up with today's cost of living. Without trying to sould like I am anti-free enterprise, the reality is that monopoly capi-talism has spawned economic crisis which attack's the people's standard of living on all fronts. One of those fronts if the basic right to a dignified and comfortable retirement. Workers won Social Security only as part of an upsurge of struggle in the 1930s. Without the fighting in the streets back then, the working class today would not have Social Security, unemployment insurance, union wage levels. Like the old cliche goes: "If you want it, you are gonna have to fight for it." That could not have been truer than in the case of today's Regan-nomics! -----30-----

## Focus Theatre Carl's Follow Spot



One of the great imponderables of theatre is just how important is it to have a name star in a show. There is currently a play trying out here where the drawing power of its two aging movie superstars seem to be its only chance of success. Conversely there is a musical that has just returned after playing here a year ago with a big star but is now with a "name" in its cast, yet which seems far better this time around.

Basically the question comes down to how good the "vehicle" is: a weak show can make it with the help of a big name but a strong show doesn't really need one.....and "Best Little Whorehouse in Texas" is a strong show indeed.. joyously fun-filled and sporting just about the most colorful language since Shakespeare put up his pen: "I'm like a countrydog in the city; if I stand still I'll get fucked and if I run, they'll bite

Described by director Tommy Tune as "the authentic cast" (they are all Texans and it rings true) there is a lively, toe-tapping excitment to this production that will give all but the most hy-pocritical viewer a delightful evening.

Although the plot is minimal and the characters sterotyped (hardly an unusual occurance in musicals) there are large dollops of good hard common sense and some excellent social commentary: "the confused against the mistaken with the well meaning screwed up on both sides."

Based on an actual incident, the closing of a well-loved and long running Texas bordello becau-se of the hue and cry raised by a "Foulwell" type TV newsman, Whorehouse delightfully satirizes

the moral majority, politicians, professional do -gooders, and even Texas football rivalries. June Terry as Miss Mona who doesn't like to be called "Madam" but runs her "house" with an iron hand nicely portrays the heart-of-gold prostitute while at the same time, manages to be believable as someone who has worked her way up on her back....some that Alexis Smith, who played the role here before never got across. William Larsen as the foul-mouthed, good ole boy local Sheriff and Kevin Cooney, as the publicity hound news-caster are both superb, with each displaying comic timing that has the audience in stitches.

However, this id definately an ensemble show with each member in the large cast excellent and thoroughly enjoyable.

Carol Hall's music is rousing and at times, haunting, especially the "Girl, You're A Woman" and the all too true to life "Doatsey Mae," sung by a waitress who dreams of stardom but knows its not for her.

What's On Tonight (call 392-6213 for info) is an interesting idea (a musical revue depicting 30 years of television) that is about as confusingly jumbled as the media it tries to depict. 
The Night The Lights Went Out In Georgia is a country-rock movie now playing at various area locations that surprisingly, in this story of the seamier side of a small time musician trying to make it big (in this case, getting to Nashville) has all the elements of classical tragedy inherent in it .... internal flaws in a character will bring about a person's downfall regardless of how much power or talent he may have. Also, as in classical tragedy, one hears the knell of doom from the begining.

Unfortunately rather than stressing this theme, the movie unaccountably sticks in an inane and false happy ending that negates the depths earlier hinted at.

A fine three dimensional performance by Dennis Quaid as a talented singer on the way up, who cares far more about womanizing and boozing than success is somewhat diminished by "wunderkind" Kristy McNichol's two dimensional portraval of his kid sister determined to make him a star ..... regardless! Excellent in smaller roles are Don Stroud as a villanous local cop and, especially, Arlen Dean Snyder as a friendly roadhouse owner. Mark Hamill of Star Wars fame is merely ludicrous as a preppy-looking Boy Scout masquerading as a State Trooper.

Although the show gives a grim and somewhat slanted view of redneck life in the deep south, it moves well, maintains an interest and, particularly for the country music fan, has a fine musical score.

This is one of the most dangerous of the groups, as they were the group which targeted key Senators and Con-gressmembers for defeat in 1980 and succeeded in most cases, one of the two exceptions being Senator Hart of Colorado and Congressman John Burton of SF-Marin. Paul Weyrich is the head of the group. Considerable






