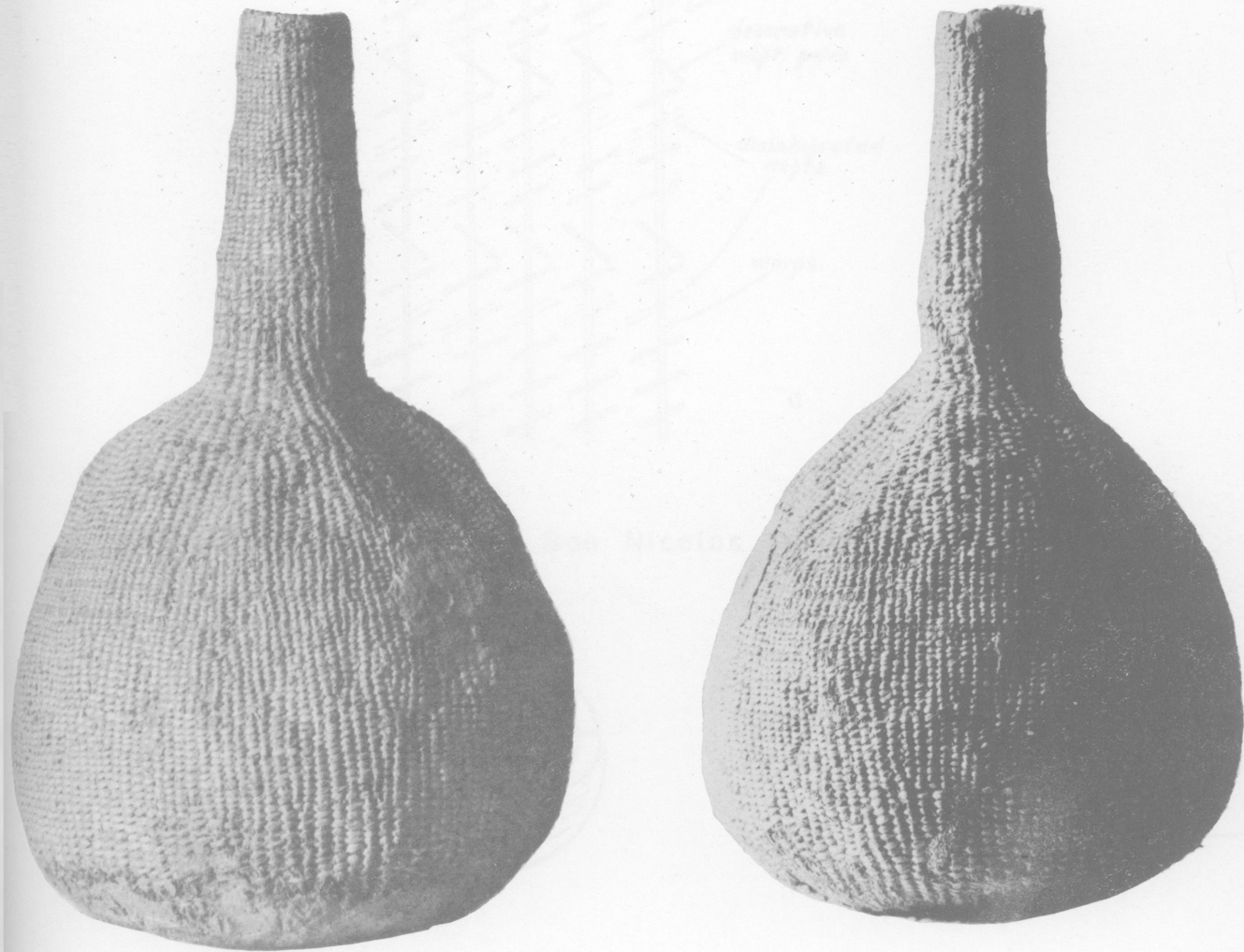


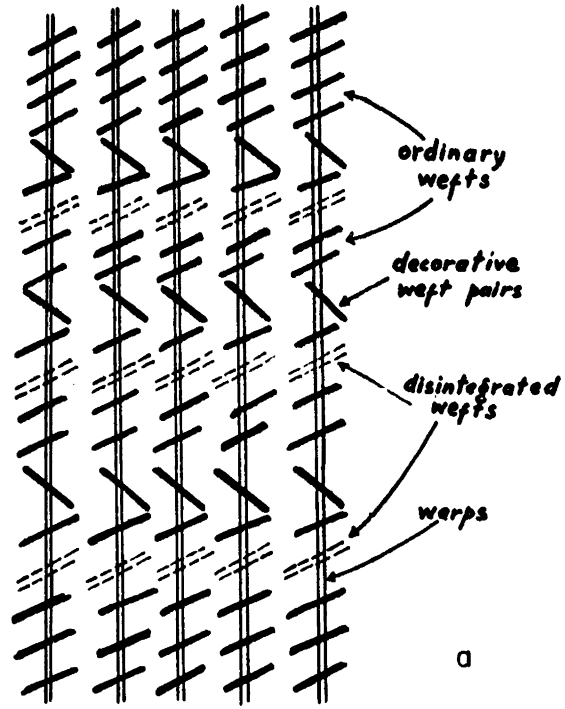

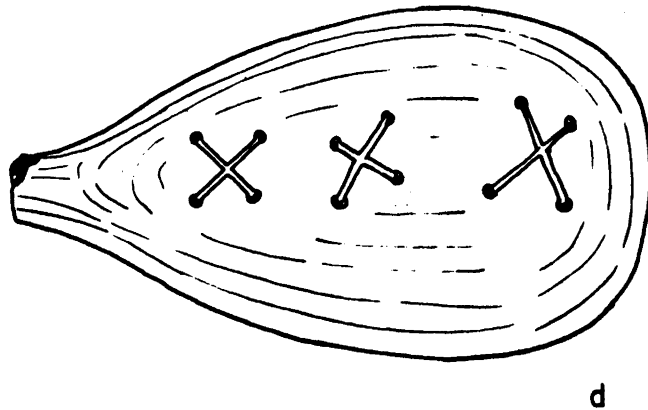

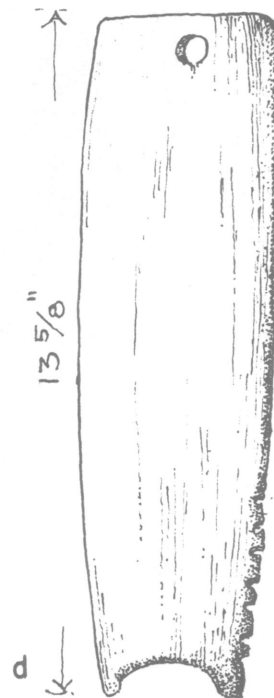
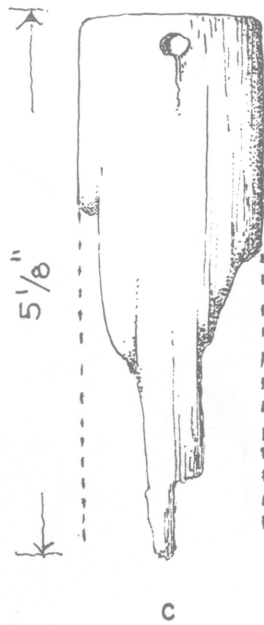

Views of Wooden Bowl from San Nicolas Island

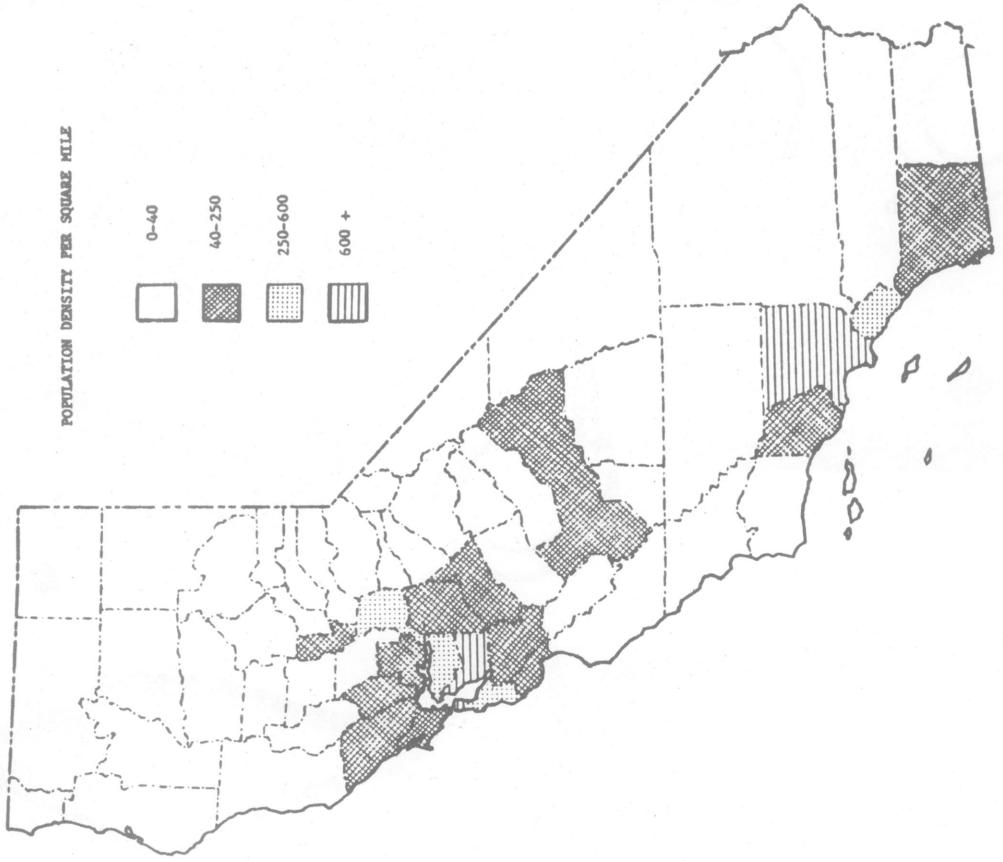

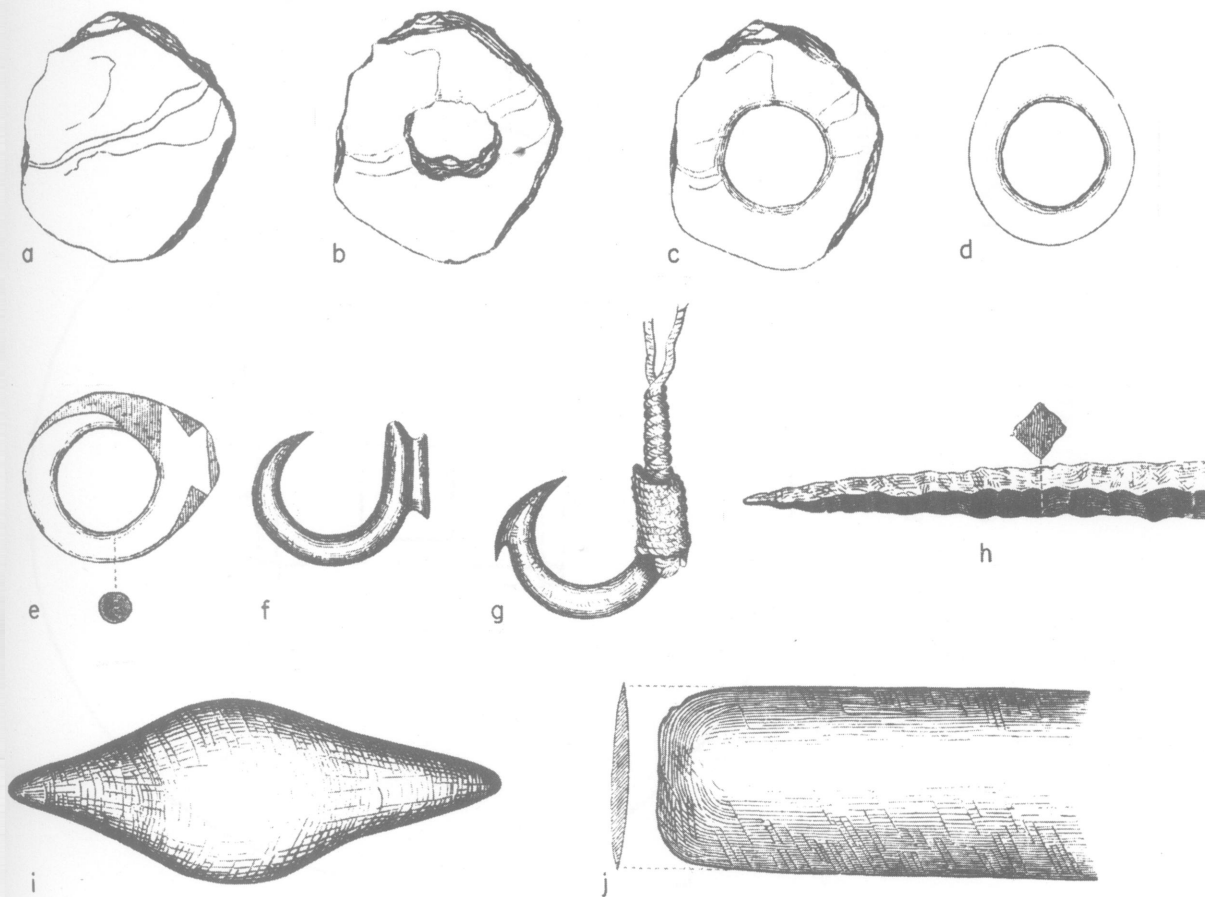

 (by tribal area)

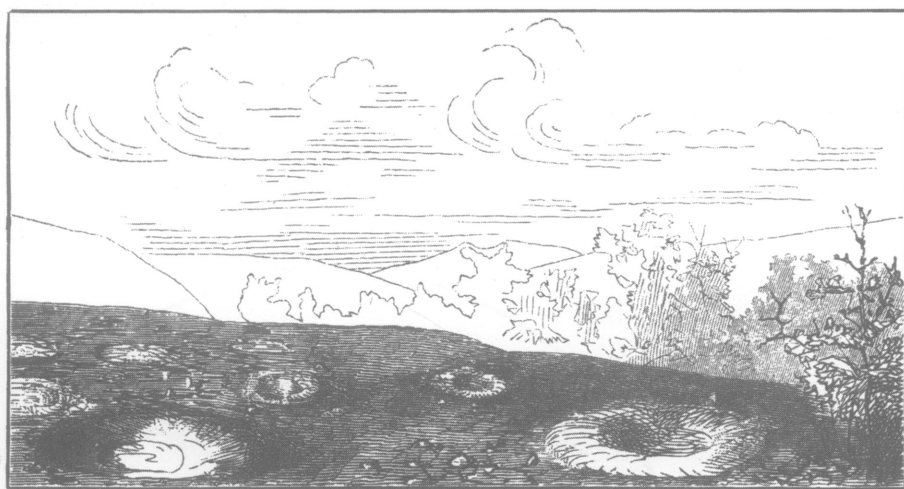

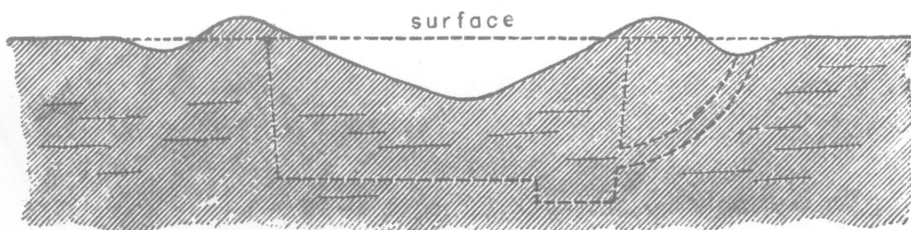

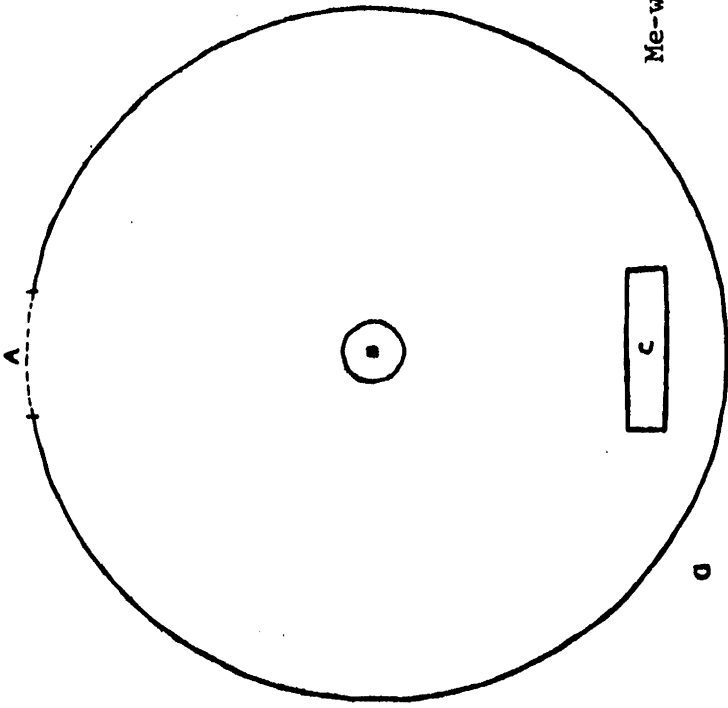
Stages and Implements of Fish Hook Manufacturing

View of Santa Barbara Coastal Shell Midden

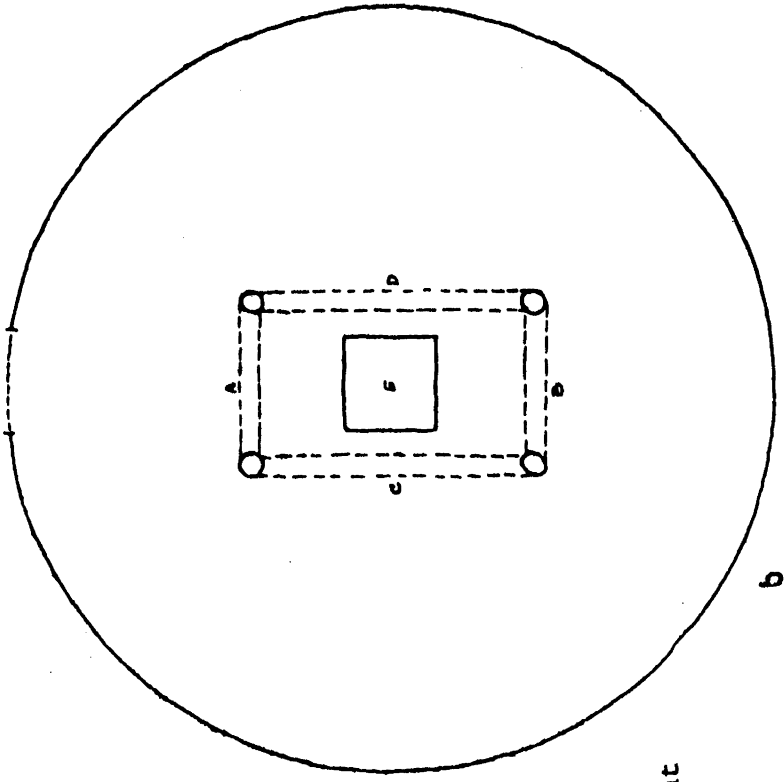


Cross-section of Rogue River Pit House



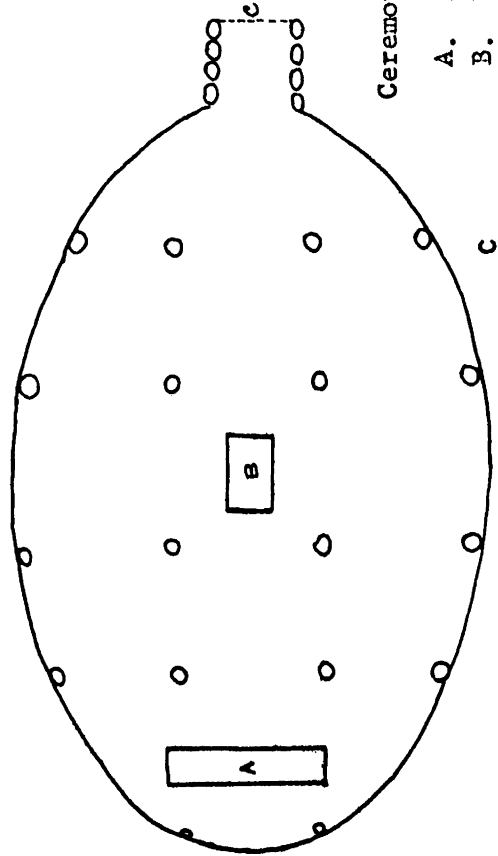
Me-wuk Hang-e at West Point

- E. Fire hole in roof

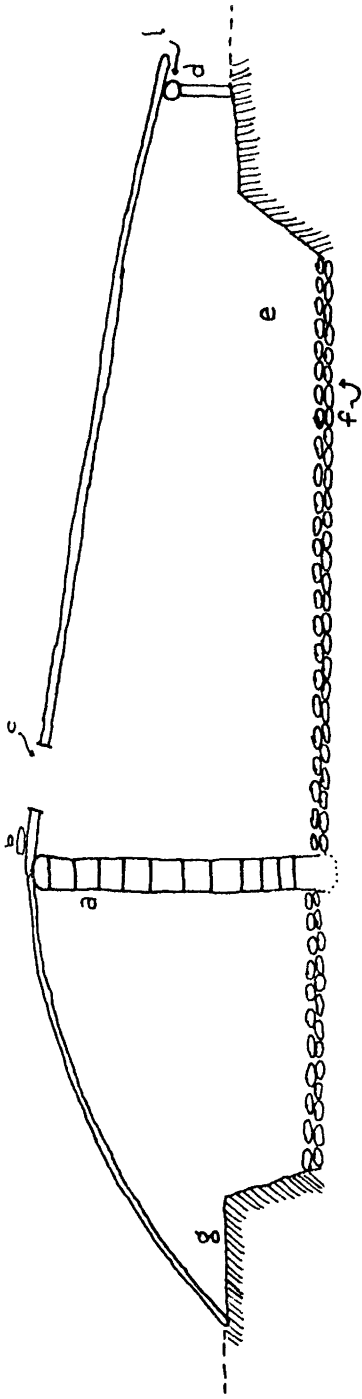


Ceremonial House at Oo-poó-san-ne

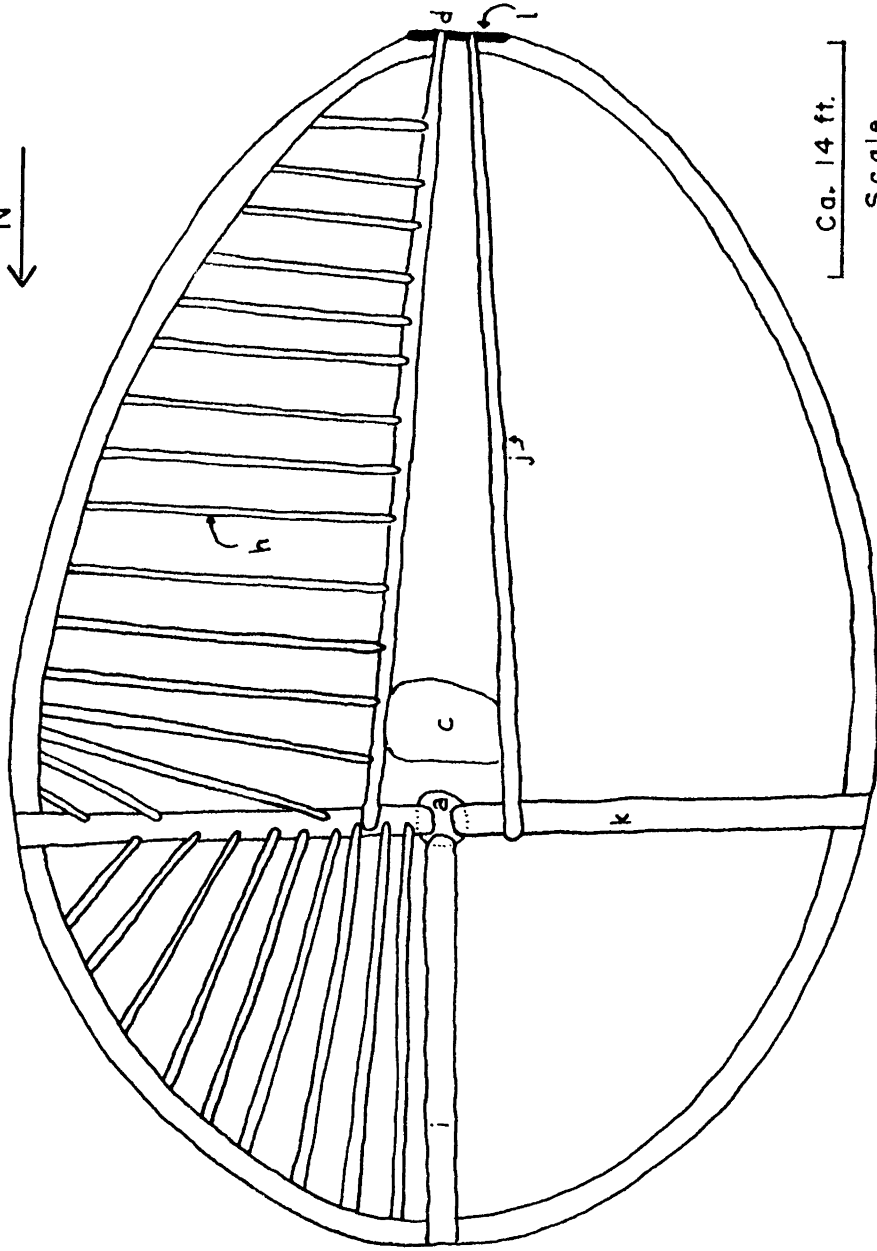

- l. Cross beam on which stringers rest



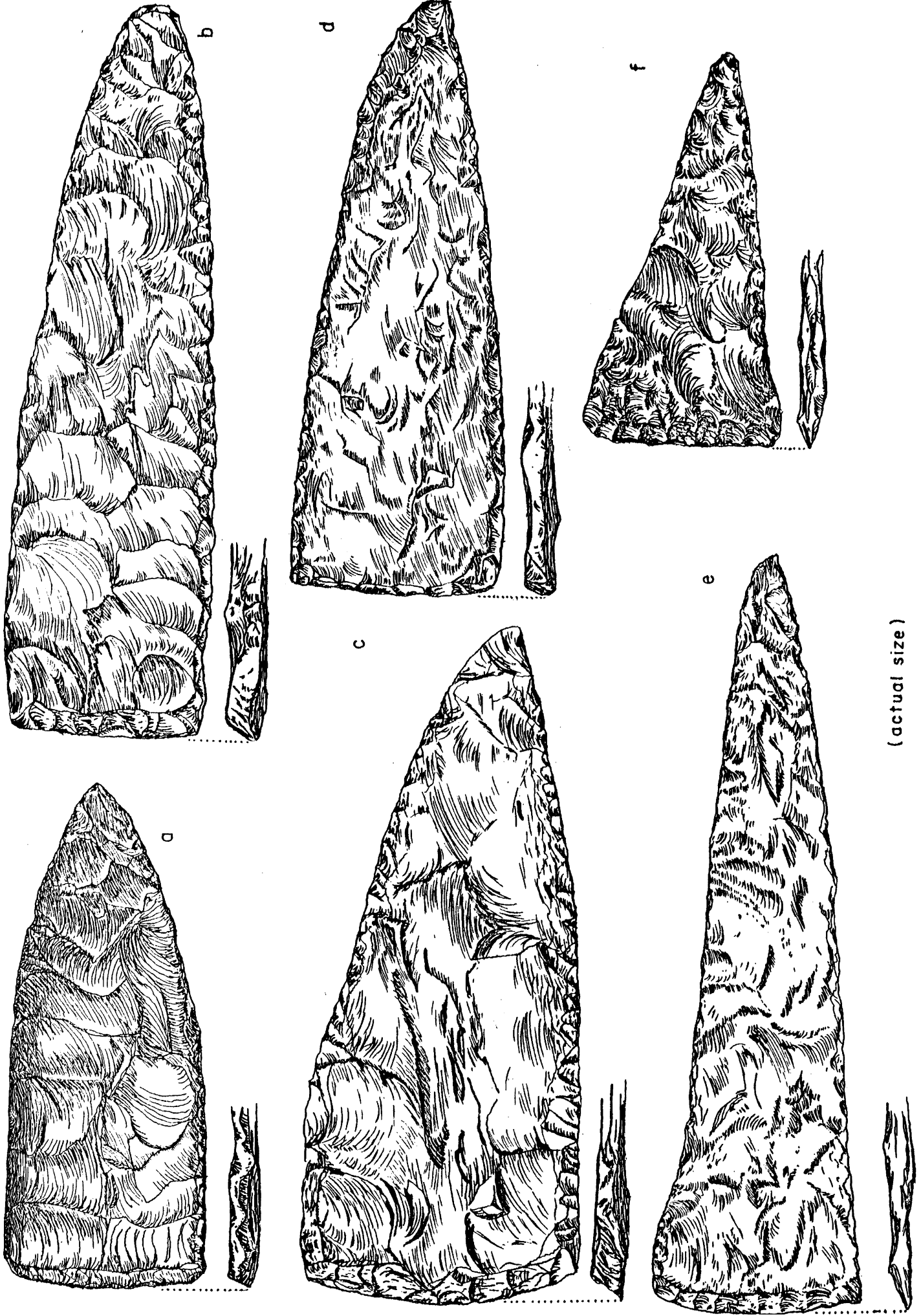

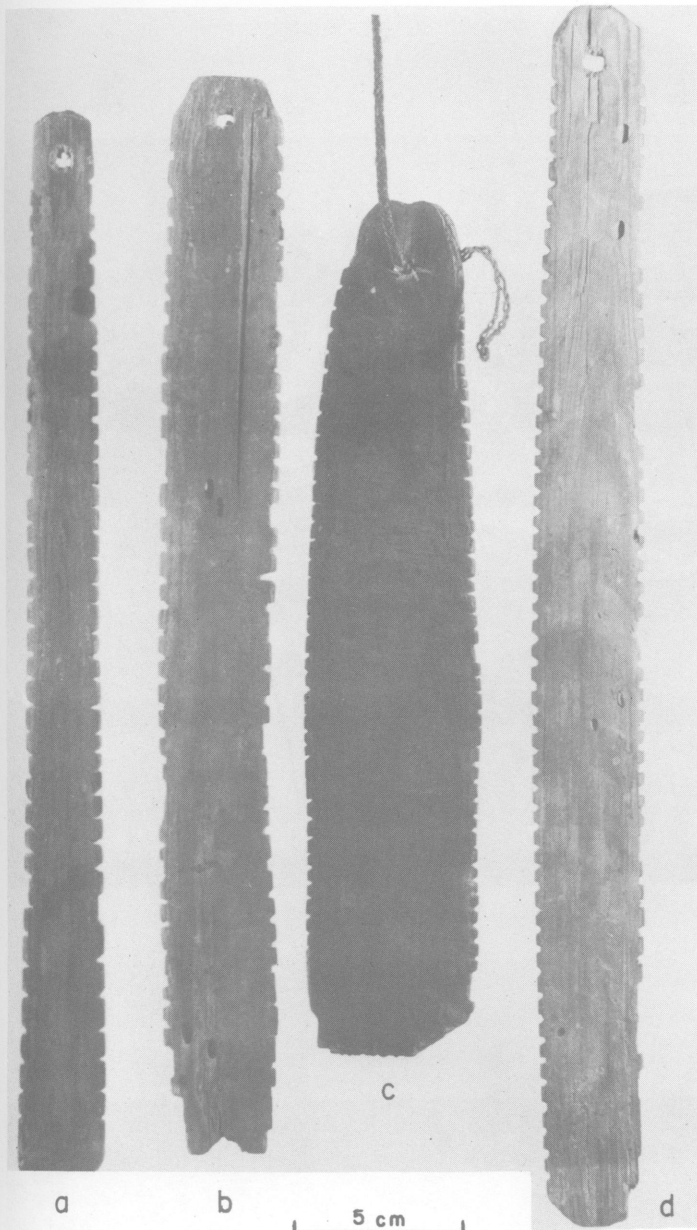

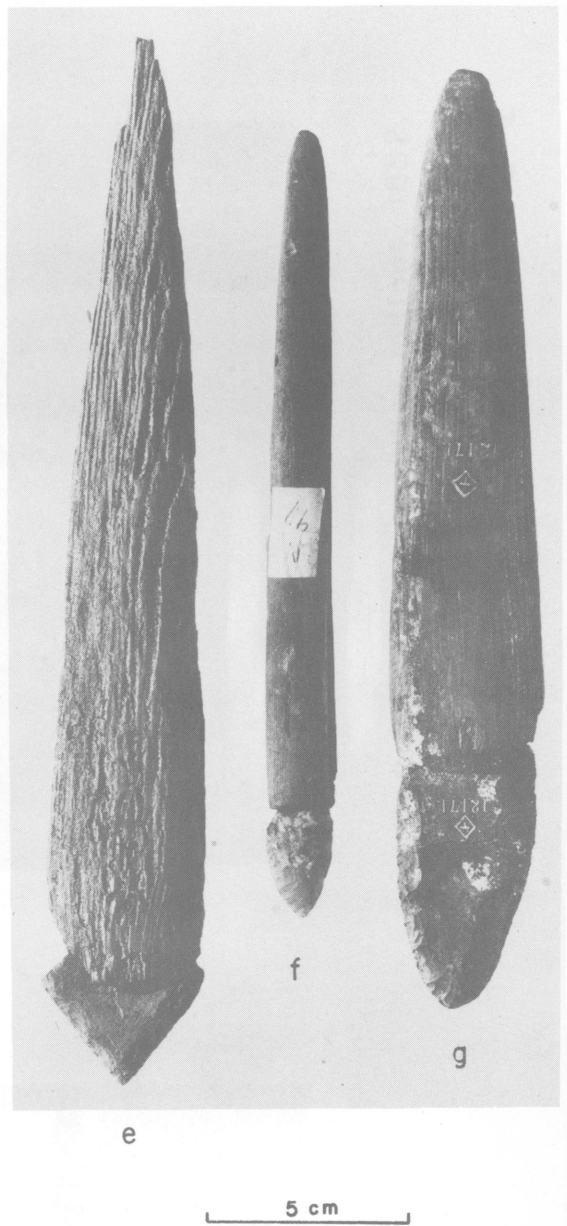

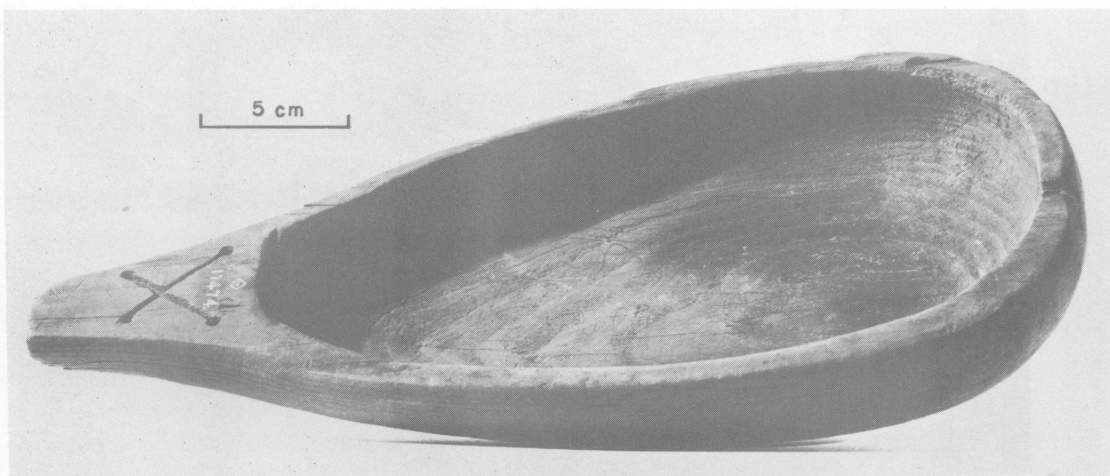
Chert Knives from Tulare County

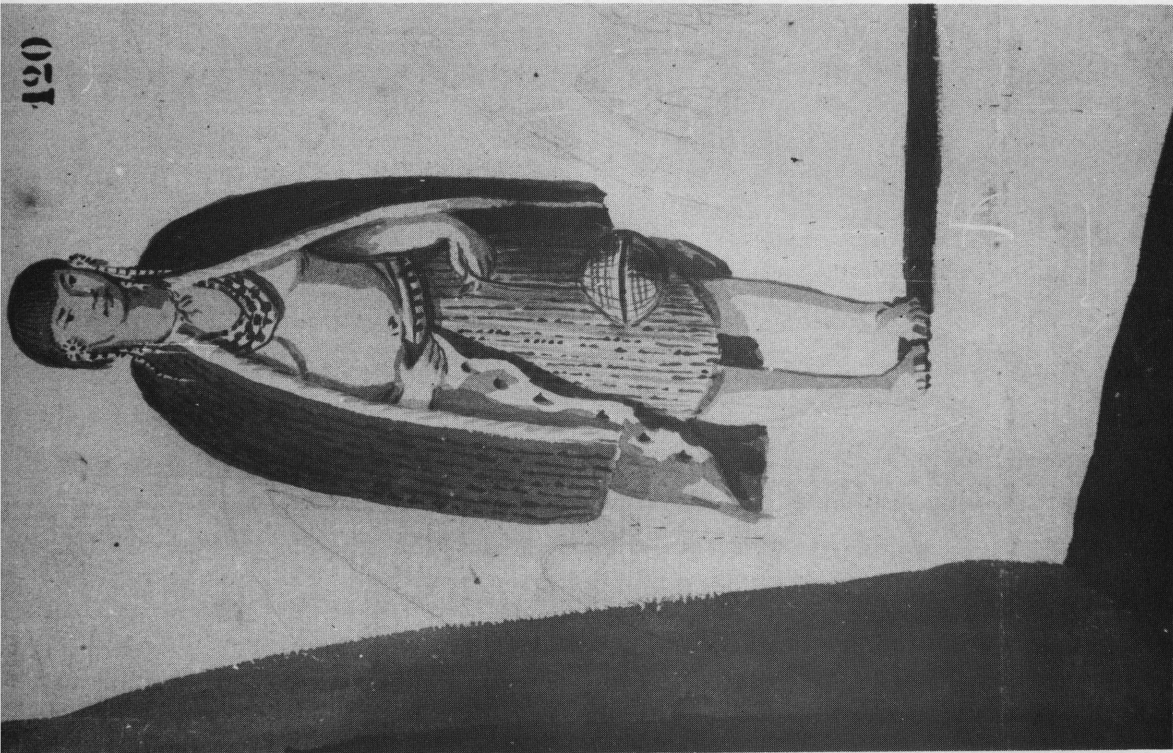
Bullroarers from Bowers Cave

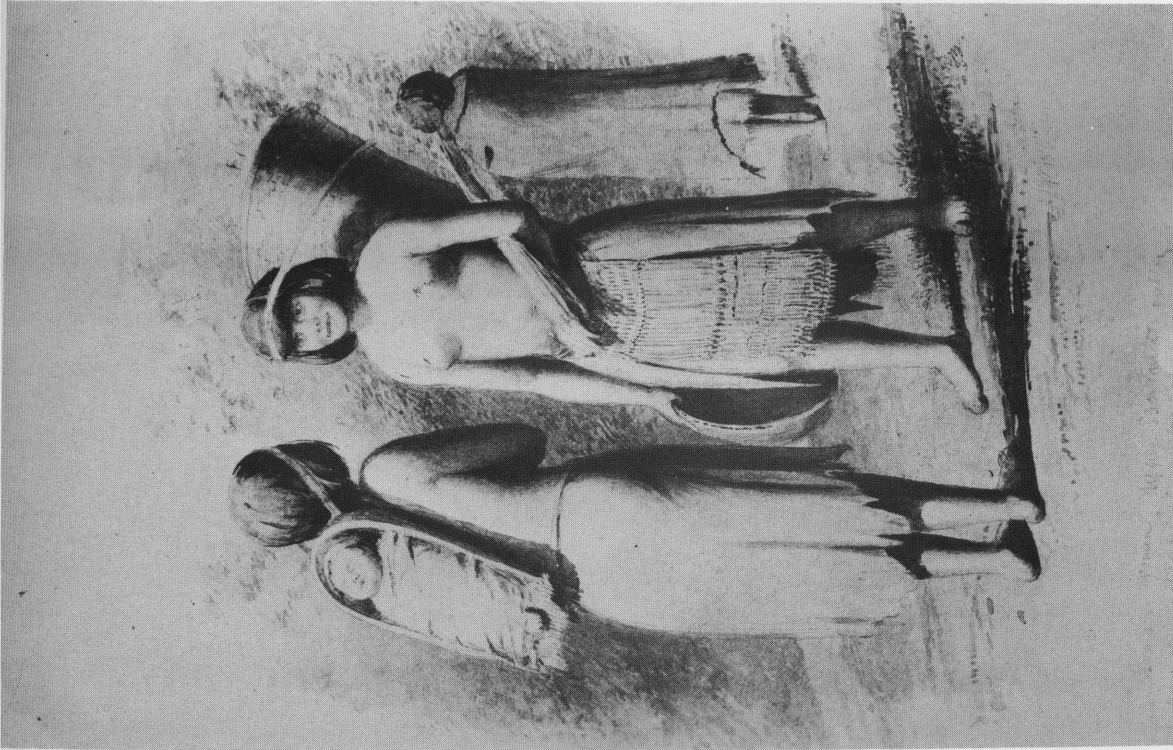
