

EDITORIAL NOTE ON PUBLICATION DATES OF ÑAWPA PACHA

There has been some delay in the publication of every issue of Ñawpa Pacha, and nos. 4, 5, and 6 did not appear until the year following the date on the cover and title page. The actual publication date should have been given in each number; the dates are listed here to remedy that oversight:

- Ñawpa Pacha 1, 1963, was published in February, 1963.
- Ñawpa Pacha 2, 1964, was published in June, 1964.
- Ñawpa Pacha 3, 1965, was published in June, 1965.
- Ñawpa Pacha 4, 1966, was published in January, 1967.
- Ñawpa Pacha 5, 1967, was published in May, 1968.
- Ñawpa Pacha 6, 1968, was published in December, 1969.

References to events and publications of 1969 occur in Ñawpa Pacha 6 in some of the last manuscripts completed for that number. The publication date of Ñawpa Pacha 7-8, 1969-1970, is June, 1971.

The reason for the delays in publication has been a shortage of publishable manuscripts. The Institute of Andean Studies is financially able to publish an issue of Ñawpa Pacha a year and would prefer to try to do so. The number of workers in Andean archaeology has now increased to a point where scholarly output should require a series such as this. Potential contributors should take note of the fact that Ñawpa Pacha is a convenient vehicle for certain kinds of articles which may not be easy to publish elsewhere, for example very long articles or short monographs; ones requiring large numbers of illustrations, especially drawings; articles dealing with a single specimen considered to have special significance; and site catalogues or other record material. Although the Inca title of the series suggests a special interest in the area of the Inca Empire, it has a good record of publication on Colombia and is open to contributions dealing with the archaeology of the tropical forest areas of the present Andean countries.
