

CORRECTIONS TO ÑAWPA PACHA 17

- p. 5. Research done in the Archivo Histórico Departamental del Cuzco in the summer of 1980 requires a correction to the discussion of the establishment of the parishes of Cuzco on p. 5 of Ñawpa Pacha 17. Montesinos was mistaken in saying that four parishes were established in 1559. According to the Libro de Cabildos del Cuzco, 1559-1560 (ms.), there were five, the fifth being Santa Ana (f. 67). The first parish mentioned is that of "los bien abenturados martires sant fabian y sant sebastian" (f. 63v). No information is yet available to explain why San Fabián was later dropped. (JHR)
