John Stanley Gross' favorite hangout was the Sutter's Mill, and he fit right in with the crowd. Gross, used the Sutter's Mill crowd to make "contacts" for various of his illegal actions, one allegedly involving a museum in Oakland where four thousand dollars worth of artifacts were stolen from. Our sources have informed us that Gross is involved in other activity, all of which Officer Curtis Casheen, Der members Department have been fully aware of, which in the opinion of certain
