Halloween Horrorll

PRE-HALLOWEEN REVELERS ON POLK STREET!!. 41 TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND FIFTY-SEVEN REPORT BEING HIT BY SFPD. Saturday night the 30th of October started out to be a calm night on Polk Street, but by Sunday morning the 31st at 2 AM, Polk Street looked like a riot situation, with police from



the Northern Station of the SFPD, at the request of certain gay businesspeople, lining the street, abreast of one another, to sweep the street clear of over a thousand persons. But, trouble began with what one observer reported to be the hitting of a person by a "door-shaker" which is a "rent-a-cop" who dresses identical to the SFPD and observers, thinking it was the SFPD, began throwing things at the police on the line. The police began swinging billy clubs, wildly hitting out at anyone and everyone, and the result was 41 persons taken into custody and 19 being booked on a variety of charges. Some Polk Street merchants praised the SFPD, while some gay liberationists denounced them for their over-reaction. The trouble began in front of Buzbys, whose part-owner praised the police, saying that those who get hit deserved to be hit, something which the GLA (Gay Liberation Alliance) president disagreeded.

District Attorney Freitas Approves of Organized Vice!

ORGANIZED MALE PROSTITUTION GIVEN "GREEN LIGHT" BY OFFICE OF DISTRICT ATTORNEY JOE FREITAS!

Joseph Fretias, elected by a substantial margin in 1975, with great support from gays, and who promised an up-front deputy District Attorney who is gay, to work in the Municipal Courts, has been prosecuting gays who are arrested for "street hustling", while allowing the organized male prostitutes to openly operate in San Franci-

D.A. Freitas is reported to have said that the ones who run the agen cies don't cause any trouble, so they wouldn't be bothered, but the street male prostitutes would be prosecuted.

In recent weeks, the police have made more arrests of male prostitutes than they have for some months, particularly around the Saint Francis Hotel.

As a result of this discriminatory enforcement of the law, a case is now pending in court in which the attorney for the defense, a man arrested for male prostitution near the Saint Francis, is attempting to have the case thrown out, showing that the District Attorney and the Police Department are not enforcing the law nor prosecuting

The "agencies" have organization and some money, and by the police picking up the independent, the person who does not want to pay a "pimp", and Freitas prosecuting them, they have joined together to give an assist to organized male prostitution!

FREITAS FIRES GOOD FRIEND OF GAYSdeputy district attorney Chris Cassidy was fired by Joe Freitas under somewhat cloudy circumstances.

Chris a very hardworking female attorney, suddenly found herself without a job, and rumors at the Hall of Justice floated freely. She has always been considered a dilligent and intense attorney. So much so, that the Public Defender's Office hired Chris as a member of their staff, a most welcome addition most all gays who are around the Courts would agree.

FREITAS DRAGS FEET ON VOTER FRAUD PROSECUTION..... This matter is still one which has not been settled to the satisfaction of the majority of the voters as yet. Freitas has avoided the issue when at gay functions of groups which he considers "hostile" to him, or at least honestly critical of his operation.

NJUSTIC

District Attorney Joseph Freitas is still prosecuting minor crimes and destroying lives. His failure to prosecute the serious crimes of violence has caused many liberal San Franciscans to look at his record of prosecution more carefully.

On September 15th, Peter Winther, 29 year old bartender at the Nothing Special got off work and was taking a short-cut home across the schoolyard of the McKinnley School, a not uncommon practice. Suddenly a huge man charged out of the bushes at him, and he ran and leap and fell off a fence breaking both arms. He awoke to find himself in the hospital and 'charged with petty theft... ...charged by SFPD Officer Bruton with having "stolen" \$28 worth of lumber, which would have proven difficult as both of Peter's arms were broken.

The police informed his employers at the Nothing Special according to Peter, and they fired him, based upon the police charge. Peter Winther, due to his failure to secure a good attorney (private) was found guilty on November 10th. He has two Public Defenders. a Jenifer Moss who assured him that victory was his, and a Allyn Yamanuchi, fresh into practice who refused to allow Peter to defend his gayness against the queer-baiting female assistant District Attorney of Joseph Frietas. He was convicted by a WASP jury, and the judge was one quite unfriendly to gays, Sammuel Yee. Winther, his arms now healed, has found work at another Castro bar, the Pendulum.

Gordon Armstrong of the Public Defender's Office has assured the editor of the GAY CRUSADER that Winther's case will be appealed, and that had he known of the what Winther described as a poor defense, come to his ear before, something was done. Armstrong assured the CRUSADER that the Public Defender's office is deeply concerned about such situations, and that every effort will be made to right the wrongs such as in Winther's case. Winther has been urged to file suit against the SFPD and against his former employer over the police having disclosed to his employer his arrest, andnagainst his employer for having fired him, even tho he had not even had a trial.







The word "union" strikes fear into the pocketbooks of most all gar resturant owners, as well as some of the bar owners.

Local 2, of the AFL-CIO are wanting to come into the gay business scene with a passion. President Joe Belardi of Local 2, which deals with resturants, bars, etc., has indicated that the unionization of the gay resturants and bars is "long overdue", and that "we do not discriminate against gays as Rev. Broshears sez that

Belardi has struck an "accord" with socialist community organizer, Howard Wallace of the Pride Foundation, who wants to see the unions in the gay scene.

Wallace was able to gain an endorsement of sorts from Belardi and Jack Crowley of the Central Labor Council, for gay rights. Wallace states that the unions may put antidiscrimination clauses into the union contracts

with the businesses now operating under union forward....if it happens. Wallace, a socialist, is to be commended for that particular portion empress contests, do they??!!

ties of San Francisco, whether the gay business- The GLA president, Ray Broshears agrees that unions are too long in coming, particularly in the big gay businesses, but that he does not want to see unions in any of the businesses that employ less than 9 people.

The union headed by Belardi cannot help the gavs except in the long run, for the unions are not as yet truly pro-gay, right now they will do anything to gain some votes.

And some of the resturant and other businesses that are gay owned, do not pay a decent living wage to their employees and deserve to have Joe Belardi and Local 2 on their necks. Some of the small, owner ran bars do not deserve to be in business, as they cause nothing but dissension and trouble.

The rights of the working individual in the gay community are seldom given any concern. Now, such people as Bob Cramer, Frank Fitch and Larry Eppinette worry about the cottonpicking farm workers in the Valley, but could care less about the working conditions of their own gay sisters and brothers right here under contracts. That in itself would be a major step their noses. But then, they don't depend upon the farm owners to hold their emperor and





REV. RAY BROSHEARS JOINS REPUBLICAN

PARTY .. With a loud, "I've had it with the corruption of the Democratic Party!", the Rev. Broshears who has been known as a conservative in Democratic circles for some years, has re-registered as a Republi-

Rev. Ray Broshears Broshears was a loud and strong stupporter of Senator-elect, Dr. S.I. Hayakawa this year, as well as supporting other Republicans, Senator Milton Marks, Dwight Tripp, and John Kirkwood. Broshears as an individual also supported Joan Hukari against Willie Brown. In 1968 and 1972, Broshears supported Ronald Reagan and in 1972 also supported Richard Nixon for re-election, an act which has caused his foes to criticise him greatly.

Broshears, with the exception of one year as a libertarian-wing member of the Peace & Freedom Party, has been a registered Republican for most the founder of the Harry S Truman Democratic

This past election, Broshears ran as a conservative candidate for the Community College Board calling for a halt to all expansion, receiving a total of 22,290 votes.

In 1975, Broshears was the big "voice" in the campaign of Gene Prat for Sheriff of San Franci sco, in which Prat polled nearly 30,000 votes. Prat, aide to Senator-elect Hayakawa is also a Republican

Broshears told this writer that he intends to be a candidate for the Board of Supervisors next year in the 4th Supervisorial district.

Asked why he chose this time the change his registration, he said, "The dirty politics of Bob Mendelsohn in his bid to unseat Republican can the lies of John Tunney and his gay supporters were too much.'

"Also, there are my views on abortion, taxes, law and order, and foreign policy which just are not in accord with the Democrats."

"I supported Jimmy Carter for president, but if he had lost, I wouldn't have shed a tear. But I did support him, for I felt the nation needed a change, and I still feel that Carter will make an excellent President, unless he surrounds himself with too many of the big union crooks!" Asked about the Republican Party in San Francisco, he said that "I feel the Republican Party in San Francisco is changing for the better, and I feel that people like John Molinari are not any help to the Party with his support of Mendelsohn. Molinari is a bleeding heart liberal who belongs to the "No Nothing Party", or should! Broshears said that he would encourage more gays to join the Republican Party in 1977.

Polk, named after President James Polk, has been the "backbone" of the various gay groups/organizations in the city, with the exception of one or two.

The gay businesses are members of the Polk Street Merchants Association, and discrimination amongst the Polk Street merchants towards gaypeople and businesses is virtual-

But Polk has changed radically within the past year, and more so in the past six months, with the street being lined with people at night, setting on cars, blocking doorways, and most of them are stoned out of their minds.

Liquor of course being the greatest narcotic, but that has not proven to be a real problem on Polk Street until the advent of the big pushers....and they are now on Polk, and with every imaginable drug known, including heroin! Certain members of the Polk Street Merchants Association

POLICE-COMMUNITY MEETING HELD......

On Tuesday November 9th, a little over a dozen concerned residents and merchants showed up at the Polk Gulch Police Community Relations Neighborhood Council meeting, held at the Redding School on Pine and Larkin.

The Director of the San Francisco Police Community Relations Unit, Inspector Rodney Williams showed up for the meeting as did Officer Ray Carlson of the same unit, (officers from the Northern Station boycotted the meeting, as Captain Joe Flynn does not recognize the group, only a group headed by a Fillmore merchant, a Howard ompson is recognized by Flynn...Thompson didate Milton Marks, turned my stomach." "And has made no bones about his feelings against Gay

people.).
The meeting was chaired by the president of the group, the Rev. Ray Broshears, and Don Berry of the Polk Street Merchants group was present, he also being the owner of Buzbys.

Several solutions outside of beating people over the head were offerred, such as, creating alternatives to the drug and street scene.

One was requesting the Community College Board to open the Redding School as a Campus. And at night, it would be a place where younger people could go to in order the learn things and as

well, socialize with other young people. Another was the Helping Hands Services Drug Abuse Prevention & Education Project being funded by various merchants in order to help warn of the drugs, and in addition, the presence of anti-drug literature and posters would create paranoia in the minds of some of the pushers as well as the users.

Rev. Broshears presented the proposal that all

parking meters be removed on the eastern side of Polk Street, in the 1300, 1400 and 1500 blocks of Polk, thusly ending the carsbarrier which allows for drugs to be freely exchanged and used, and as well ending the setting on the cars by those who flock to the area. It was also pointed out that many of the pushers use the cars for drug transactions, and as well, some vans have been used as whore houses while parked on Polk in the 1400 block.

The 1400 block was cited as the central problem area, with Buzbys and the Palms being the central areas of congregation by the young people...too young to gain admittance to the bars, etc.

Halloween night the the night before resulted great crowd control problems on Polk.... add to that the regular nightly crowd problem, and you had a riot situation, which did occur on Saturday night early Sunday morn-

The problem was that tens of thousands of people came to Polk street to see some kind of parade, which there was not and never has been. And this year, there were only 4 buses compared to 7 last year and 14 the year before that, showing that certain old traditions are ending, but the Polk Street merchants failed to recognize this and did not prepare for the changing times. A suggestion by Rev. Broshears that bands

be sat up at Sutter-Polk and Sacramento-Polk on bandstands would greatly reduce the anarchistic operation of this past Halloween. New Years is coming up, and it must be done.

MURDER AT STATE

HOSPITAL
VENTURA: (SPECIAL FROM A GAY CRUSADER CORRESPON-

DENT LIVING THERE, NEAR CAMARILLO.) A Grand Jury investigation into deaths at the Camarillo State Hos-

pital set this correspondent into searching into anything sexual on the deaths. Those who have been accused of being concerned with the deaths

are for the most part, black and chicano nursing assistants. As of this moment they have been accused of negligence, but other charges may arise out of the deaths.

The case of Clarence Cormier was one of the more dramatic deaths which have led to speculation of possible manslaughter charges being brought up.

Cormier, 33 died a violent death on February 18th, 1974. Three aides have testified that Cormier picked the three of them up and threw them across the room. The three say they grabbed Cormier and dragged him to his bed, strapped him down, and administered a shot to calm/tranqulize him.

Cormier died of strangulation......although all three denied having chocked him.

Testimony has been taken that many of the attendants used wet towels on other inmates to "choke" them into unconsciousness when they became violent, and it is estimated that 17 persons died as a result of the "prescribed choking" which led to strangulation death.

Rape has also been one of the chief topics of the grand jury inves-

One newer hospital official told this writer of rapes of women and men that have been related to him by the various patients. She cited that rape against younger boys by the male attendants

was common of the complaints. She also cited that all of those accused denied the male child rapes. It is expected that the grand jury hearings at Camarillo run run

until mid-November. At that time, the grand jury will deliberate and more than possibly hand down serious verdicts.

Meanwhile, the deaths of 29 inmates at Atescadero State Hospital, where sex offenders are sent, are being looked into, and the possibility of a full scale investigation are more than possible, that according to one friendly administrator at Atescadero.

Criminal libel is something which has never been condoned by the Federal Courts.....and criminal libel in the so-called "gay" newspapers of San Francisco has become me their stock in trade....without it, many of them would have folded long ago.

Recently, the publishers of the BAR (Bay Area Reporter) and DATA BOY were sent notice concerning their printing of criminal libel. Both ignored the notices, in turn, attorney B. J. Beckwith, the attorney for the person who was libeled has prepared the first draft of a suit for \$18,000,000 against each of the publications, and as well, against the author of the said articles which were printed freely in both papers.

Both papers have since presented further proof of malice, by printing further articles libeling the client of attorney B.J. Beckwith.

Recent court decisions have shown that for publication s to continue printing said type articles is proof of malice. Witness the Synanon suit against the Examiner, and Pat Montaban's suit against KGO/ABC, both of which won easily, large sums of funds.

Freedom of the press on news items has never been challenged, but, freedom to libel and slander people has never and shall never be upheld by any court.

These publications, which call them selves "newspapers" are anything but that except for the fact that they are printed on "newspaper pulp".

San Francisco has in fact only one bi-weekly NEWSnewspaper which can call itself without any fear of challenge by respected newspaper authorities, and that is the SENTINEL, published by William Edward Beardemphl, arch foe of the editor of this paper.

The GAY CRUSADER is a newspaper in every sense of the word as well, in that it presents 80% news, 12% advertising, and 4% "gossip", and 4% public service adsand the GAY CRUSADER is the official voice of the GLA (Gay Liberation Alliance), published by the GLA, and in cooperation with Helping Hands Community Services......the CRUSADER is the only gay publication that is NOT for profit.

The SENTINEL has proven to be even more biased in it's news reportage than the CRUSADER, if that was possible, but, it does make an attempt to cover the news of San Francisco, and to provide respectablity to

The same cannot be said for Sal Sufron's journal out of Los Angeles (3,889) in San Francisco....in that his publication was at one time all gossip and advertising. Since the Beckwith legal action letter to them, they have changed to a greater extent. But, they still use people who feel that tearing down individuals and gay groups is far more important than building....evidence of which has been prepared as afidavits in the multimillion dollar law suit.

The KALENDAR does not claim to be a NEWS paper, but an entertainment journal, which is what is has been for some years now, doing an excellent job in this area. The owner, Dick Jay and editor, Dennis Charles are to be commended for their efforts.

The BAR is more that 60% advertising according to a sampling of the past issues, and the "gossip" made up a large portion of the so-called news. The news-news that is in BAR, is taken from other publications and press releases, with the exception of-what comes from Paul D. Hardman of the Pride Foundation, Coalition to Defend Gays in the Military, and the California Committee for Equal Rights who also writes a column in the SENTINEL.

There is some theater from a couple of writers, and not much more.

The DIFFERENT BEAT is doing well, with Donald Cameron Scott seeking new horizons for gay publish

And the RIP-OFF RAG is just that! The publisher is Ta Ta Peter, a nice person, but the print run is very small, as the minds of several of the columnists appear to be....for they like a couple of the DATA BOY columnists prefer it appears, to tear down, instead of

The BAR, RIP OFF RAG, and DATA BOY, all three appeal to the purient interests of the typical barhopping, BQ (Bar-queen), whose lives appear to revolve in and around the gay bar scene.

These publications in their pages have not carried articles denouncing the drug plague in the gay communites,....the appear to care little about the growing problems of VD. And they all three appear to care less about the terrible classism whichexists in the gay communities. And they have defended the gay bars/resturants as being fair employers and not being in the least racist. So, as they depend upon the bars for their income...could you really classify BAR' RIP OFF RAG & DATA BOY as NEWSpapers????




The question that this reporter asks then, where does the person who has no money go to, sleep at? Think on it!



Pictured also are Flame, Hector, and the GAY CRUSADER'S own Cari Cavalli and his other half, Darrell Swei-


Some of the pictures were taken at a bar un-named on Polk Street, and the reaminders on Polk itself.


Several residents as well as merchants have already indicated that they will oppose the closing of Polk Street next year, unless efforts are made to organize the Halloween activities more clos-

Memorial For Cady Iris at Ma Bell!

(reported by Lee Raymond)

To tell the story of Lady Iris, I must go back to the morning of October 21, 1976, alovely morning, so I decided to walk to my place of business (that

business being Ma Bell's on 3rd Street & Harrison). While passing St. Patrick's Church on Mission Street near 4th Street, I found a pumpkin on the sidewalk, it seemed to be a good pumpkin of about 3 lbs.

The one flaw was that it's stem was broken off, but I decided to take it, even with the hole in it's head.

So, down third street I go with pumpkin in hand, facing the beautiful golden sun rising behind the dull concrete skyline of south of Market street. I put the pumpkin on my desk and proceeded to draw a face on it, but thought it didn't look quite right with the hole in the top of it, so I decided to

put it on the bottom with several paper napkins under it. Now, everyone who can make a face with triangle eyes and "missing teeth" in a jack 'o lantern knows how easy it is, but, I decided to be different, so with a magic marker, I went to work on the pumpkin. I gave it flashing long lashed eyes, smiling cupie doll lips, and slash bangs. I made a bow out of paper napkins and with a paper clip to hold it together, I stuck it into the pumpkin. All of this took all of two minutes.....what took alittle longer was to come up with a name for my new foundfriend. By noon, I had the proper name for this pretty pumpkin, her name would be "Lady Iris."

Everyone in my section got toknow and love the Lady Iris and showed her the respect befitting a

lady of quality. She was honored by being greeted each day by many of the employees in that section with a lovely pleasant "good morning Lady Iris" before greeting the mere human co-workers (a custom I started).

Lady Iris became quite a celiberity and her popularity grew....many workers from other parts of the building would walk by just to get a look at t the noble pumpkin, like Russian peasants pleased to get a glimpse of Catherine the Great on her balcony.

As days passed Lady Iris grew ill, she developed a leak from where the stem was missing, she start ed sinking fast, and as if that weren't enough, some mold developed where the paperclip was stuck in, which I noticed on the 26th. I had the task of informing the peasants that Lady Iris had contracted cancer of the clip, so that night after work, I prepared a funeral for our noble friend... anxd on the dark day of October 27th, Lady Iris was pronounced dead and placed in a coffin of purple satin trimmed with pink flowers and purple, "Lee Raymond, Think Love" buttons. A candle was placed on either side of her coffin, and all day long the peasants would come by to

pay their last respects to the still smiling, bright eyed beautiful thing. During my afternoon break I changed from my purple shirt to my white collar and black jacket, and with "good book" in hand, the memorial services for the great Lady Iris began...as the pea-

sants gathered around to mourn the great lady. The services were short and simple. A photograp er was on hand to capture this brief precious moment for the history books. The cover of the coffin of light grey cardboard was lowered and

Lady Iris was put to rest.....in the waste paper

I worked late that night, and the cleaning person came by to empty the waste paper basket at the time I was readying to leave and I wasn't noticed watching the person finding the box with the cross on it marked, "Here Lies Our Beloved Lady Iris"....caution was taken..for who knew what lay in store..a dead bird, a pet rat or just what? Curiosity was powerful and caution was thrown to the wind.....the lid of the coffin was lifted just as I passed thru the threshold of Room 310, and a burst of laughter echoed across the large room and escorted me down the hall...the laughter seemed to get louder the further I got from it. I thought for sure they'ed find the body of that cleaning person next morning, laughed to death.And that is the story of Lady Iris at Ma Bell!

"MAGNUS is published quarterly by the MAGNUS Collective, which consists of Sam Blazer, Tom Kennedy, rama Michael Rosner, Denny Smith and Richard Wilson.' Some of the illustrations in it were done by the talented Lawrence Goldyn, Daniel Arcos, Tom Till, Robert Morgan, Michael Starkman and Lupine Child.

The members of the MAGNUS Collective appear to be members of BAGL (Bay Area Gay Liberation) also. They are six white persons who have been a longtime in putting together this magazine named after Magnus Hirschfeld who was a militant German socialist and sexual liberationist (1868-1935).

Magnus does NOT accept any paid advertising, not being capitalists they say, nor do they accept help/donations from persons whom they disagree with politically!

Articles in the publication run the gamut of what you would expect from socialist homosexuals.

Most of the articles are very well done, and the photos in the publication speak for themselves, as they all have a very pronounced message.

It would do the average "bar-queen" a great deal of good to buy a copy of MAGNUS (\$1.50) and read it, for it would only help to raise their consciousness above the waistline and out of their booze.

MAGNUS is a most ambitious undertaking, the finest since GAY SUNSHINE.....a publication which began a an "underground" gay liberation newspaper, and is now a "Journal" filled with interviews of authors, poets, etc. In MAGNUS, you find some of the "spirit" of the old Gay Sunshine, and as well, bright and inovative writings. The poetry is interesting, particularly those written by Tom Kennedy. Articles written by Kennedy appear to have the most depth of any found in MAGNUS.

The tribute to Michael Krauss who was killed in an auto is quite moving. Obviously Michael had been quite involved with the Magnus Collective. Yet, the tribute did go a bit too political, more of a commercial for socialism at times. But, Michael Krausss was a fine human and de serves all the praise given.

"Fragments of Metaphysical Pornography" by Martin Worman was a most interesting "trip" into the "unknow

Arthur Evans, one of the finest writers gay liberation has given to the world, has a piece called, "Five Fallacies About Gay History".....something I would advise all to read, and ponder on. Very good and so true.

The article on gay socialist action project in New York is quite tired and boring, in fact the only article I would urge you to skip.....typical socialist ego-tripping, filled with much much retoric.

But then, Tom Kennedy's, "A Closer Look at Socialist Feminism" is not the best of his writings in MAGNUS. For he too finds himself knowingly or unknowingly, wandering down the propaganda road, but still well done

The article, "Root Street" by Tim Corbett is very well done and is applicable to all of us, but first remove the socialist commercials and it is a fine piece of gay writing. And I would commend to all of gay America, the poem by Tom Kennedy called, "Enlightenments In Toad Hall Or the Buddha As A Hot Number".

It is just fabulous, especially when you look at the pathetic older men who set amongst the cheap rip-off hustlers who hang around Mason and Market Street's infamous "meat-meet rack".

The only hypocriscy that I found about the publication was their refusal to accept a paid ad from the GAY CRU-SADER, yet they placed "free?" ads in for publications of a socialist nature from the Lavender & Red Union of Los Angeles, and RFD (A magazine for country faggots). MAGNUS.....an effort worthy of your finacial help. MAGNUS....a journal of socialistic gay liberation writings.....but most importantly, they are of gay liberation. MAGNUS ... a publication which forces any thinking huma man being to deal with their sexist natures, and their




GONORRHEA CASES NOT BEING CURED BY THE **USUAL PENICILLIN SHOTS! A GRAVE DANGER!**

In Atlanta Georgia, the Director of the National Center for Disease Control, Dr. Wiesner, related to the new spapers gathered, that more cases of a new gonorrhea strain that kills the antibiotic intended to cure the disease, were confirmed, and federal health officials were concerned that it may spread further.

The Center said that 12 cases of gonorrhea that penicillin could not cure have been detected in California, and Virginia.

Wienser said that the penicillin-resistant disease "could put a control burden on us. It is an important public health problem. Preventing it's spread is going to entail the cooperation of medical people and patients." He also stressed the need for the news media to help.







MAO!

1893 - 1976

On October 1, 1949, Mao Tse-tung stood at Peking's Gate of Heavenly Peace and proclaimed to the world, the People's Republic of China, stating that the...... "Chinese people have now stood up!"

LANDMARK COURT DECISION MADE!

San Francisco Police arrested Harry Kirk on July 21, 1973, on the basis on statements by two juveniles that he had performed sexual acts on their bodies, Section 288 of the California Penal Code. In a majority opinion written by California State Supreme Court Justice Stanley Mosk, the decision was overturned.

Mosk wrote, "Juries had been asked to confirm what psychiatrists told the Court."......"Surely we have not gone so far toward 1984 and Orwell's bleak prospect of government by experts that

in a proceeding in which human liberty is at stake, the function of our juries is reduced to 'confirming' the guesses of doctors hired by the State."

This decision will certainly affect other similar cases in the future, and as well, be the basis for appeals of other cases already decided.

Harry Kirk, following the jury trial was committed to a state hospital as a "mentally disordered sex offender," which the law defines as "any person who by reason of mental defect, is predisposed to the commission of sexual offenses to such a degree that he or she is dangerous to the health and safety of others."

This was the first jury trial on this issue in San Francisco. The jury was instructed to weigh the "preponderance of evidence" and a unanimous verdict was NOT required! The Court of Appeals reversed the guilty verdict, basing it's decision on recent State Supreme Court cases, on grounds that such cases should require proof beyond a reasonable doubt, not merely by a preponderance of evidence.

Prior to the ruling, the court said prosecutors had been instructed that to publicly brand a man as a mentally disordered sex offender and confine him or her for life imprisionment in a penal instution, he need only persuade 75% of the jurors and by only 51% of the evidence, rather than the 100% "beyond a reasonable doubt." Harry Kirk felt he had been denied his rights to due process and to equal protection under the law, in contravention to the Sixth and Fourteenth Amendments to the Constitution.

Mentally disordered sex offenders proceedings in California are treated the same as juvenile court proceedings, in that a key issue in each is the definition of a juvenile or a mentally ill disordered sex offender, for both proceedings, it is the status of the individual, rather than the validity of any specific criminal charges that is determined. In 1939, California created procedures for involuntary civil commitment. The mentally disordered sex offender received neither the evidentiary protections granted to the accused criminal, nor much of the rehabilitative care envisioned for his status.

Actually, the sex offender may be a victim of society in it's overprotection of itself, according to Harry Kirk.

In the California prisions, there are thousands who have been sent to prison under the mentally disordered sex offender law. The total was not available from the Department of Corrections.


San Francisco's GLA (Gay Liberation Alljance) has several cases they are now communicating with in an effort to obtain their release, but the it is a costly venture, as lawyers do not work for free.

GLA president, Rev. Ray Broshears, who has brought to light some of the injustices done to gaypeople who have been committed under the MDSO (mentally disordered sex offender) statues, pointed out that many of the so-called MDSO's who are at Atescadero (California Hospital for the Criminallt Insane), are victims of tortures in that institution. He reported that several deaths in which hospital (prison) personnel have been invovled in, have not been properly investigated.

Various so-called "treatments are still being conducted at Atescadero, such as the "electro-penile response therapy" treatment, in which a person, male homosexual, is strapped down to a table in a darkened room and then a slide projector shows nude pictures of women and of young men. The doctors? have attached a device to the penis of the individual, and if the penis responds to the nude male pictures, they are given an electric shock via the penis. And when they are shown a picture of a female, and erection is obtained, they are not given any further electric shocks.

California State officials deny that the treatment is used any longer at Atescadero, but two patients who were released in September related the horrors committed upon their bodies by the attendants, which included male

Leo Fultz, who was released from California Men's Colony at San Luis Obispo, related to the GLA that treatment of inmates has not changed much, but that they are more careful in carrying them out, so the public does not see or hear about it.
