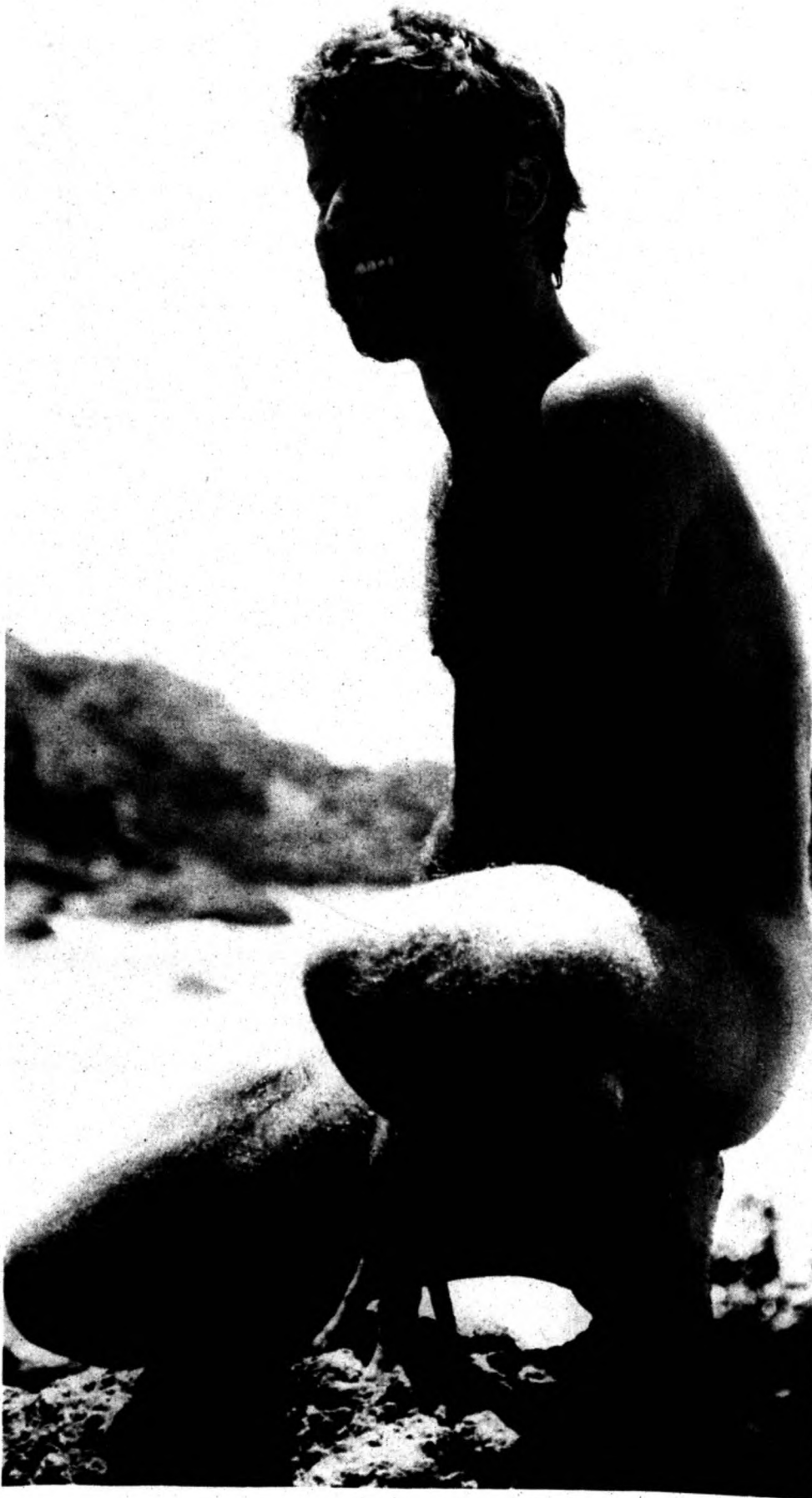

## NEWS Brief

WICHITA: This Kansas city has just passed a gay rights ordinance similar to that passed in Dade County. It passed 3 to 2. A citizens group said they would seek a referendum to overturn the new law.

SAN FRANCISCO: Mayor Moscone appointed an interim member of the Board of Supervisors. Police Commissioner Jane Murphy. Mrs. Murphy takes the place of Dorothy Von Beroldingen who has been appointed a judge in the Municipal Court. Mrs. Murphy is very pro-gay, according to Elmer Wilhelm of the Minutemen Democratic Club who is her friend.

HOLLYWOOD: Richard Pryor who caused considerable turmoil with his slurs against gays at a gay rally at the Hollywood Bowl, told reporters that he is not sorry for it and would do it all over again. Pryor says that he is not anti-gay...only anti-racist!

SAN DIEGO: The Republican State Central Committee handed Senator John Briggs a setback....not did they not adopt a resolution of support for his anti-gay teachers initiative.... they passed an individual rights resolution which was a direct slap in the face of the State Senator from Fullerton. Gay Republicans on hand were overjoyed over the events.

SALT LAKE CITY: Gay Mormons United is the name of a Latter Day Saints Church gay group which has organized. S. Matthew Price is the national director.

SAN JOSE: The police in San Jose arrested 12 people in one week through entrapment in a peep movie house. San Francisco attorney B.J. Beckwith is handling some of the cases.

SAN FRANCISCO: Two gay candidates for the Board of Supervisors...Ray Broshears and Andrew Bettancourt have received the endorsement of the United Republicans. The GOP is certainly changing for the better.

SAN FRANCISCO: Black police officers have charged racism in the SFPD. Their charge is being supported by this paper and the NAACP.

## "GAYS HELPING ME!....." Senator Briggs

BRIGGS TELLS REPUBLICAN CONVENTION IN SAN DIEGO THAT GAYS ARE HIS BIGGEST HELPERS IN CAMPAIGN TO END GAY TEACHERS.....! State Senator John Briggs of Fullerton, told Republicans gathered at the State Assembly of the G.O.P., that "Gays are helping me...without their assistance, the progress we have made in gaining signatures would never have been possible!" Briggs went on to tell the Republican faithful that the vehement opposition by militant gays has given him the necessary publicity to help him thus far. He related how his aides would phone gay groups in cities in which he is to appear, and let them know he was in town. Briggs said that "That crazy minister who is on that hunger strike, and I wonder, hunger from what, is really helping me, for everytime

the news media give a blurb about his condition, they tell about my initiative." "That homomister is a big help to me." Briggs was referring to the Rev. Troy Perry of MCC who went on a "hunger strike" to raise money to fight Briggs, vowing he would die if necessary. Briggs told reporters at the Convention that he would gain the necessary amount of signatures and his initiative would be on the ballot in June and it would pass, and gay teachers would be outlawed. When asked about the statewide committee being formed by Assemblyman Art Agnos of San Francisco to fight his efforts, Briggs said..... "Well, Art is a funny fellow and he represents all those homosexuals, so I guess it just means more publicity for me, and Art will be helping just like the others are!"

## TENANTS OPPOSITION TO R.A.P. Growing Fast .....

TENDERLOIN TENANTS ORGANIZE TO OPPOSE PROGRAM TO DRIVE POOR, GAYS, ELDERLY OUT OF THE AREA BY SLUM-LORDS!

The RAP (Rehabilitation Assistance Program) project, being pushed so hard by the EXAMINER, and homosexual candidate for supervisor.... B. King, is being opposed by a growing number of renters in the area, as they have just begun to learn that their very future is in jeopardy, due to the greed of the slumlords of the Tenderloin. RAP is being opposed by the TPTA (Tenderloin/Polk Tenants Association) and by Supervisor candidates, Rev. Ray Broshears and Paul Denning. Also in opposition, but for other reasons than those of TPTA, are the SF Neighborhood Legal Association, represented in the RAP hearing before the Planning Commission by Gabriel Gesmer. Chester Hartman, of the Planners Network and Frances Brown of the California Legislative Council on Older Americans are also in opposition to RAP. King, supported by Henry Weinstein of the EXAMINER, and Mark Forester, a professional grant-writer, all joined forces in support of RAP. King who owns property in the Tenderloin, which would qualify for the RAP taxpayers money to renovate his building into a luxury gay apartment building, said he opposed the

stand of TPTA chairman, Rev. Ray Broshears, who asked the Planning Commission for an EIR (Environmental Impact Report) and to recommend to the Board of Supervisors that rent control be enacted in the city. Rent Control is the theme of the campaign of Broshears. Commissioner Sue Bierman was the only Commissioner who showed any real concern about the people who would be displaced/relocated by the RAP project. Anyone on welfare would not qualify for relocation by the city under the guidelines of RAP as presented by City Planning Director, Rai Okamoto. Okamoto and others suggested voluntary rent control. "Voluntary rent control? what a laugh", said Broshears, as he was scoffed at by B. King and his ally, Mark Forrester. Broshears went on to say that none of the slumlords, King in particular, would practice rent control on a voluntary basis, that it must be mandatory if the old people and the poor are to be protected. More hearings on the Tenderloin RAP proposal will be heard at the City Hall, Room 282, on following Thursdays. Those who support rent control in the Tenderloin in the RAP area, are urged to show up and testify at the hearings as they are public.

## King Clarification .....

Barry King, candidate for Supervisor in the 4th District, who has fallen to fifth place in most polls, has asked for a clarification concerning his property connections in the city, which are considerable. Mr. King in a letter to the CRUSADER in which he slandered the editor and his leading opponent, complained that the October issue 1977 of the paper had printed some misinformation concerning him. As this is the October issue of the paper, we can only assume that the "alert" king must have meant the August 1977 issue, in which Mr. King, refusing to be interviewed concerning his property holdings by various publications and individuals he does not like, was linked falsely to the property, Gartland Apartments (hotel) in which 16 persons burned to death. King was asked about his connection with the woman who owned that property and he said it was none of our "4% business" King did along with Rossetti of Grub and Ellis Realty and an attorney Don Richards Stephens purchased the 441 Ellis Street property which King gives as his address, from Beatrice F. Presant's Summit Land Company. King has a DBA as Montgomery Property which manages various property in the Tenderloin area. Mrs. Presant's partners said that King did not manage the Gartland, but that information came to us in September, so we apologize to King for this error, which he could have cleared up, months ago, but refused to do so. King said in an EXAMINER interview concerning 441 Ellis, "By taking a building close to condemnation and turning it around you can make a good return on your money.... provided you buy below market value."

## POLK PUSH IS ON! POLICE ARE BUSTING

TENANTS MERCHANTS REBEL AT STREET VIOLENCE AND THEFT. MORE POLICE ON POLK STREET, AS "JUNKIES", "PIMPS" & "PUSHERS" INVADE AREA!

The SFPD is making more arrests on Polk Street, the "Gay White Way" of San Francisco, as knifings, beatings by pimps and pushers increased in the area. There is also the element of straight young punk-types who have been blocking doorways of stores causing troubles to the customers and to the merchants alike.

Some elderly people are afraid to come onto Polk Street now, as many elderly have been knocked by youths who are "grab-assing" (horsing around), and by so doing, hurt innocent people passing by.

Many have tried to turn Polk Street into a "Playground" for middle-age hippie types who are behind a small group who oppose more police on Polk Street.

One of the "over-the-hill" hippie types, who is doing alot of the trouble making, is a man discredited in the gay liberation movement back in the early seventies, a Stephen Matthews who has brought other such people as Pat Brown into the area to help them in their vicious attacks upon the visitors, residents (who pay taxes) and merchants alike.

One merchant who asked not to be identified, fearing violence from Matthews and his "groupies", said that, "These creepy punks want Polk to be a playground for them and their drugs...drugs are 90% of the problem up here, if the SFPD were truly serious, they would get down on the backs of the pushers who don't live in the area, who we see out in the streets, dealing to these kids and over aged hippies. While some were picketing the Nito Burrito at Sutter & Polk, one of these pushers was selling quaaludes to some of the pickets!"

The problem has been made worse on Polk Street, by the sensationalistic media reporting tactics of KTVU (Channel 2) reporter Jim Clancy who has distorted the situation all out proportions, who is no where correct on the subject.

Joyce Shank of KGO (Channel 7) has to an extent, more accurate, but still overlooked all aspects of the problem. Ms. Shank, who is anti-gay, dwelt on the gay and not the straights (pimps, pushers and young girls).

The Polk Street Merchants Association, headed by Pat Short of Sukker Liquors, and Marty of Town Squire, met with the Mayor and the Chief of Police on the subject.

The Chief of Police, as long as a year ago was well aware of the growing problem on Polk Street, but refused to take any action in the matter.

Gain has been forced to take action as a result of the most recent meeting, but all merchants agree that the SFPD are most ineffectual thus far.

The windows of Town Squire, Newmeyers Bakery, and others, have been broken out by these young kinds of people, who are "grab-assing" around.

A year ago the young kids used to hang out in the 1400 block in which Buzbys is located. Buzbys used to call the plice on the kids regularly. This year, with the burning of the nearby Raven, 1499 Polk, the kids moved down to the area of the BAGL which also includes the Town Squire. Due to the brightly lit windows of Town Squire, it made a perfect hang-out area. The Town Squire has refused to turn out or down their lights at night. It is "hard to shoot up in the dark" one kid said, as to the reason for moving away from the unlit area outside of Buzbys. Further police action will be taken in the area, with State Narcotic officials saying they too will increase their activity on Polk

## The Satanic Khristians -

The newspaper at the left is real...it is published in Bass, Arkansas by a radical right wing group of KKKhristians. The TORCH supports the KKK as well as the Nazis. The editor, T. Arthur Robb sounds like some of Hitler's side-kicks, except he is right here in the United States. TORCH calls for death for homosexual peoples in no uncertain terms. It is frightening. Both the ADVOCATE and the GAY COMMUNITY NEWS have already done articles on the TORCH newspaper, and the reaction is frightening to many gays who are finding that the whole world does not exactly love us. The ADVOCATE asked the U. S. Attorney General to take action against the TORCH for calling for the deaths of gays...but this publication and those of us on the staff call for a psychiatric examination with an eye towards commitment in a hospital for the criminally insane for T. Arthur Bass and his entire staff. One woman who was "interviewed" in TORCH said, that gays should be removed from society, and when asked how she would go about "removing" them, she replied, "Well the Bible I believe says to stone them (not true). Of course they did not have electric chairs in those days, nor did they have gas chambers. I am not really fussy about the method only the results, a clean decent environment for my children". The woman was "upset" over gays attacking Anita Bryant over Dade County. Robb himself wrote, "It is true that they will have to die (homosexuals)...the whole filthy bunch of them. The sooner the better! The American people will put up with their filth and degeneracy only so long and then they will do what all good men and women of courage must do when called upon to protect their families and loved ones". The editorial in TORCH reads, "The White People's Committee to Restore God's Laws is not embarrassed to admit that we endorse and seek the execution of all homosexuals."

Although they call themselves "Christian" most all Christians have denounced them as a bunch of "lunatics" and people who have never recovered from "Hitler having lost world war II." "Overgrown punks playing Nazi and playing with fire, for they are sentencing themselves to prison, if not death."

In one old issue of TORCH they refer to Black people as "monkeys" (guess that is where the racist member(s) of the SFPD got that idea to place on the Park Station bulletin board attacking the black police officers who got promoted recently). Robb refers to former Congresswoman Bella Abzug as "an ugly Jew". The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Arkansas has told the CRUSADER that his office can do nothing about TORCH unless we can prove a connection between some death here (or anywhere) and the TORCH editorial. In plain words he said we would have to prove that some one killed someone because of what he read in TORCH. CRUSADER contacts in Arkansas, are trying to procure the mailing list of the TORCH, which should prove interesting.

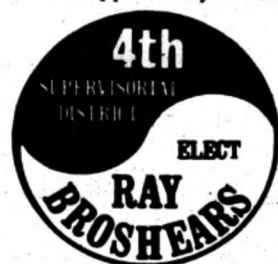

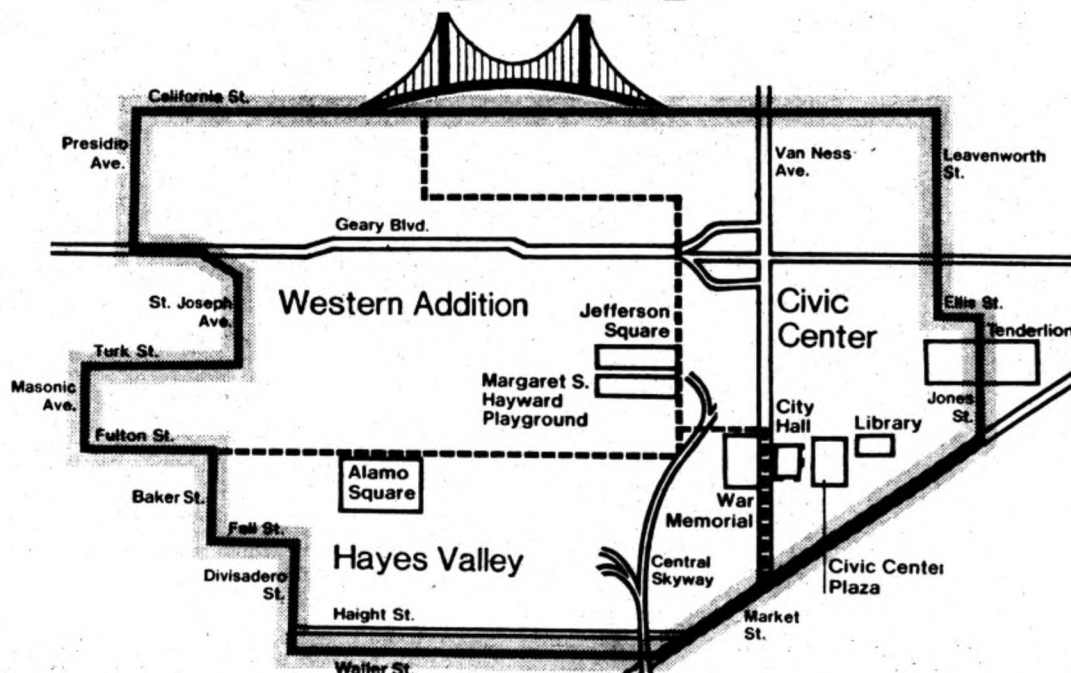

## T. ROOSEVELT CLUB ENDORSES

The Teddy Roosevelt Republican Club at a Political Brunch at the Casa de Cristal recently, met with incumbent City Treasurer Tom Scanlon, and City Attorney hopeful George Agnost, and several candidates for Supervisor.

As a result of that meeting, and other meetings elsewhere, those members who chose to attend the endorsing meeting of the T. Roosevelt Club did so, and make their selections.

In the City Attorney race, George Agnost was endorsed. It was pointed out that his two opponents do not have the experience, one, Gil Graham, being the lawyer for the radicals at the International Hotel and other radical leftist causes.

Reilly only has his father's name to fall back on. And we all remember George Reilly of the days when the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board and the office he now holds, were one in the same.

George Agnost is the man for the job. For the post of City Treasurer, Tom Scanlon was chosen, as he has the experience,

and his administration has been free of any scandal. Kay Patchner is a consumer advocate which has nothing to do with being City Treasurer, and she is too far to the left politically.

The Club urged a strong yes vote on Tom Scanlon.

Supervisor in 1 was Tom Bomar.

District 2, Les O'Shea was chosen, due to his strong stands on individual freedoms and his long involvement as a civic leader.

District 3, John Keker was chosen over Molinari who chose to ignore the event and the Club entirely and has many of the John Briggs people working for his election.

District 4 was the Rev. Ray Broshears, who has been working for civil rights and gay rights for the past 17 years.

District 5 went to Andrew Bettancourt, who without a doubt is the best qualified candidate in that area.

District 6 went to Carol Silver. & 7 to Bob Gonzales. 11 to Max Woods.

## Polk Street Merchant Defends Ray Broshears

OWNER OF SUKKERS LIQUORS DEFENDS REV. RAY BROSHEARS WHO IS UNDER ATTACK FROM POLK STREET PUNKS!

To Whom It May Concern:

On Monday October 3rd, a group of people picketed NITO BURRITO because of increased police activity on Polk Street.

They were shouting anti-Broshears comments, blaming him for bringing more police to the area.

I explained to them that the Polk Street Merchants Association requested the extra police because of the increased violence directed against the gay community.

Yet, the anti-Broshears comments continued.

I had a meeting with the leader of this demonstration three days before this.

He knew it was I as President of our Association who had met with Mayor Moscone and Chief of Police Gain as reported in the EXAMINER and the CHRONICLE...who had requested more police protection.

I personally am not supporting the Reverend's campaign for Supervisor of District 4.

But, I feel that this attack on the Reverend was POLITICALLY MOTIVATED...trying to discredit him.

I feel this is totally unfair.

Polk Street encompasses more than one District, why do these people call themselves voters of only one District when the problem of Polk Street covers two Districts.

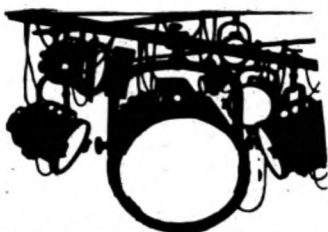

# CARL'S Follow Spot

"SURPRISE" IS REVIEWED ..... "EVOLUTION OF THE BLUES" IS GIVEN A SECOND LOOK  
"BULLSHOT CRUMMOND" IN IT'S THIRD YEAR ..... "THE GREAT AMERICAN BACKSTAGE MUSICAL"

**SURPRISE!**.....  
"Cut Glass People" . . . . . liv'ng in a cut glass world" a hauntingly beautiful song inventively staged, rather well, sums up **SURPRISE!** the new musical at the Alcazar Theatre on Geary Street. Based on Moliere's "Tartuffe" with music, lyrics, and book by Kelly Hamilton, "Surprise" has facets that are brilliant, a glowing patina and some very sharp edges.

Potential viewers should bear in mind the words "based on"; this is not the French classic with musical numbers added and those expecting such will be disappointed. Although character names and the plot, for the most part, are followed, characterizations are greatly changed. . . . especially that of the title role who is no longer the sly fox, cunning and devious, but a broad, farcical and all too obvious charlatan played to the hilt by Ken Fleishour who uses his enormously expressive eyes to great advantage. Believable? Not particularly. Amusing? Very definitely, yes. Yet, it is Dorothy Holland as "Elmire", the wife of Tartuffe's benefactor and object of that rascal's lust, who earns the greatest plaudits. Immensely believable as the only one to keep her head "when all about are losing theirs and blaming it on . . . " her, she walks off with both act-

ing and singing honors.  
(It is in this contrast between the broadly drawn Tartuffe and the realistic Elmire that the sharpest edge is apparent, due seemingly to director Leslie Abbott's being unsure just what style of show he wished to bring in. This uneven style is a flaw but not a fatal one.)

Dottie Cartwright as the maid Dorine is fetchingly vivacious with a pleasing voice but as lead singer in most of the production numbers fails to stand out and too much of the time is lost amongst the chorus. Ken Letner as Orgon, the gullible dupe of Tartuffe's hypocrisy, projects a bumbling but stubborn bourgeois hilariously although he is unfortunately weak in his vocal numbers and dances. Ruth Kobart, in her all too brief appearances, is living proof of Stanislavsky's famous line about no small parts. With a look, an inflection, a gesture this complete professional dominates . . . but being a pro, she never steals . . . every scene she is in.

However, it is in the three younger principals that the show's greatest strenght, and charm is most apparent. Harrison Grady (Damis), Kimberly King (Marianne) his sister, and Mark Rabin (Valere) her lover add sparkle whenever on, especially the latter two who mime the positions of figurines while Elmire sings the aforemen-

tioned "Cut Glass People", to this reviewer not only the high point of this show, but the finest single number seen in San Francisco this year.

The chorus is blousy, colorful and dances with the verve if not with originality. The set by Marc and Sally Rosenberg is charmingly evocative of 18th Century Paris, as are Craig Hampton's costumes. Ramon Stanbury's lighting varied nicely with the play's different moods, except for a bank of five spots, set up stage and aimed front which, when on, shown spill light disconcertingly into my eyes.

Kelly Hamilton's music and especially his lyrics, with at times triple and even quadruple internal rhymes, lift what otherwise might have been a mediocre show into a most pleasant evening's entertainment. It is doubtful if **SURPRISE!** will set any records for an extended run but although not without flaws, it is tuneful, amusing and brimful of charm as well as bawdy. . . . (Mr. Fleishour's burlesque rendition of "Under My Frock" leaves little doubt as to what word is really meant) but never in "Shockingly Bad Taste", a sprightly patter song sung by Miss Holland. If not great it is definitely good with its strengths far surpassing its weaknesses and a good choice for those who wish to be entertained.

## EVOLUTION OF THE BLUES

It is in its fourth year at the ON BROAD-WAY Theatre and billed as the longest running musical in the city's history has become the old cliché: "A legend in its own time."

A history presented through revue type-numbers of blues music from its start to the present day, I found it interesting rather fascinating except for the lead dancer, very possibly the most exciting performer now appearing in the city. Good music, good numbers, a bit tedious at times, especially a tap dancer who went on too long and while hardly in the "must see" category, still an enjoyable show.

## BULLSHOT CRUMMOND

Is in it's third year at the HIPPODROME Theatre is light, breezy, campy and fun, fun, fun FUN! Startling special effects, not the least of which is Bullshot's endowment when he appears in bathing dress, unbelievably quick changes and Mark Blankfield's seven different characters ranging to a stuffy old Etonian on his way to Ascot to a delightful take-off on Quasimodo hippity-hopping around stage, put this tongue-in-cheek satire of British detective story heroes in the not-to-be-missed listing.

## THE GREAT AMERICAN BACKSTAGE MUSICAL

Is at the MONTGOMERY PLAYHOUSE and is "right on" for nostalgia buffs and devotees of late, late night movies on TV. Pleasant and amusing but hardly memorable it satirizes Hollywood movies of the early forties and cunningly evokes that period.

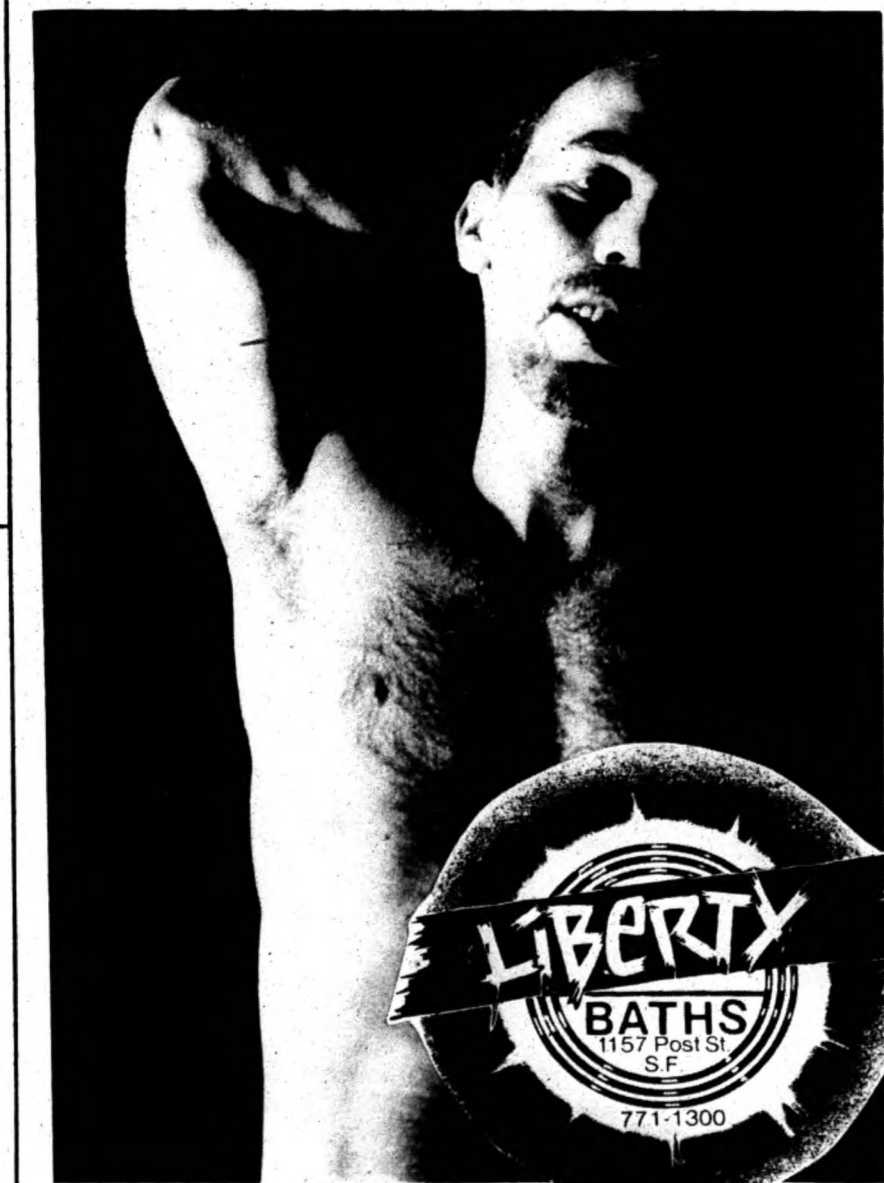
**NOTE**.....Since this is the first of a series of monthly columns, perhaps a few words are in order as to how I see a reviewer's task and what readers may expect.

# Douglas Dean Goodman ~ Tells All ~

This is the fifth in a series of interviews with famed author, actor and director, Douglas Dean Goodman. Mr. Goodman continues in this issue, with his marriage to Marlene Dietrich's daughter Maria Sieber.

**DEAN:** At Maria's party we had a chance to really talk to each other for the first time. We discovered we like the same books, the same films, the same music . . . and found out we had alot of other things in common, too. The hostility I had felt toward Maria disappeared. We spent the night together.

**CRUSADER:** Were you working at this time?

**DEAN:** Yes. The day after Maria's party I was due on the set at Univer-sal, where I was playing a small part in a picture called, "Top Man" with Donald O'Connor . . . Maria came on the lot to see me. I sneaked off the set, and we drove in her car high up into the Hollywood Hills, where we parked and made love.

**CRUSADER:** Sounds pretty romantic.

**DEAN:** We were young and tremendously attracted to each other. For the rest of that first week we were together almost constantly . . . at the beach, for moonlight drives, seeing movies, making love and getting to know each other. By Friday we were discussing what kind of a family we were going to have, and on Saturday night . . . while dancing at The Palladium . . . we became engaged. It happened very fast.

**CRUSADER:** Had you met Dietrich at this time?

**DEAN:** No. She was in New York on vacation. She returned in mid-August, just a few days before Maria and I planned to get married.

**CRUSADER:** How did she react when she heard the news?

**DEAN:** At first she was furious. Maria and I had been engaged for about six weeks, then, but Marlene and I had never met and she knew nothing about me. Some of Maria's friends were very jealous . . . they didn't want Maria to marry me, because they were afraid they'd lose her themselves. So they got to Marlene with all sorts of stories about me . . . there was "something funny about my relationship with Ouspenskaya" and I was a fortune hun-

ter and I was Jewish (they thought) and I was gay and I was just interested in Maria for what help her mother could give my career. Etc., etc., the gossip was all very vicious and calculated to ruin the love Maria and I had grown to feel for each other.

**CRUSADER:** You really did love her?

**DEAN:** Of course. She was beautiful and talented . . . And remember, at that point of my life, I was oriented towards women. I'd had a few casual sex experiences with men, sure, but women were my main interest. I was excited as all hell about our coming marriage.

**CRUSADER:** So you and Maria went ahead with the wedding plans, in spite of Marlene's objections?

**DEAN:** That's right. Actually, I guess you could say we eloped. Maria had a terrible fight with her mother and left home on the night before our wedding. Marlene did everything to persuade Maria she shouldn't marry me, but it was no use. Maria had made up her mind.

**CRUSADER:** Would you say that Maria and her mother had a close relationship?

**DEAN:** It was a love-hate relationship, and I think it continues to this day. . . . Maria had a very unhappy childhood. She adored her mother, in a sense, but in another way she resented her and felt very inferior to her. She never believed she could compete with her mother's beauty, and she still doesn't. But, really, Maria was just as beautiful as Marlene, in a younger and softer way.

**CRUSADER:** Tell us about the wedding.

**DEAN:** It was on Saturday, August 23, 1943. That morning I had a call from Marlene's lawyer, asking me to come to his office. Maria was terrified. She was afraid her mother was trying to buy me off. But she consented to a talk with the attorney, if I promised I wouldn't change my mind about anything.

**CRUSADERS:** What questions did the attorney ask?

**DEAN:** He was a nice guy and very embarrassed by the job he had to do. But Dietrich had told him to get specific information from me. Was I or wasn't I Jewish? How did I plan to support Maria? Etc.! I told him I wasn't Jewish, but if I were I certainly wouldn't be ashamed of it. I told him neither Maria or I wanted a cent from her mother. We had our own plans about how we'd earn our living. So he said, "I'm sure if you'd just talk to Miss Dietrich, she'd understand. Why don't you call her?"

**CRUSADER:** Did you do that?

**DEAN:** Yes. On the telephone she was so very cool. But I told her I really loved Maria. I told her I knew the marriage might even hurt my career . . . my agent had warned me the publicity might be bad . . . but I was still going ahead with it. Didn't that prove what I felt for Maria was real?

**CRUSADER:** Yes. And what was Dietrich's reaction?

**DEAN:** Finally she said, "Well, maybe everything will work out all right."



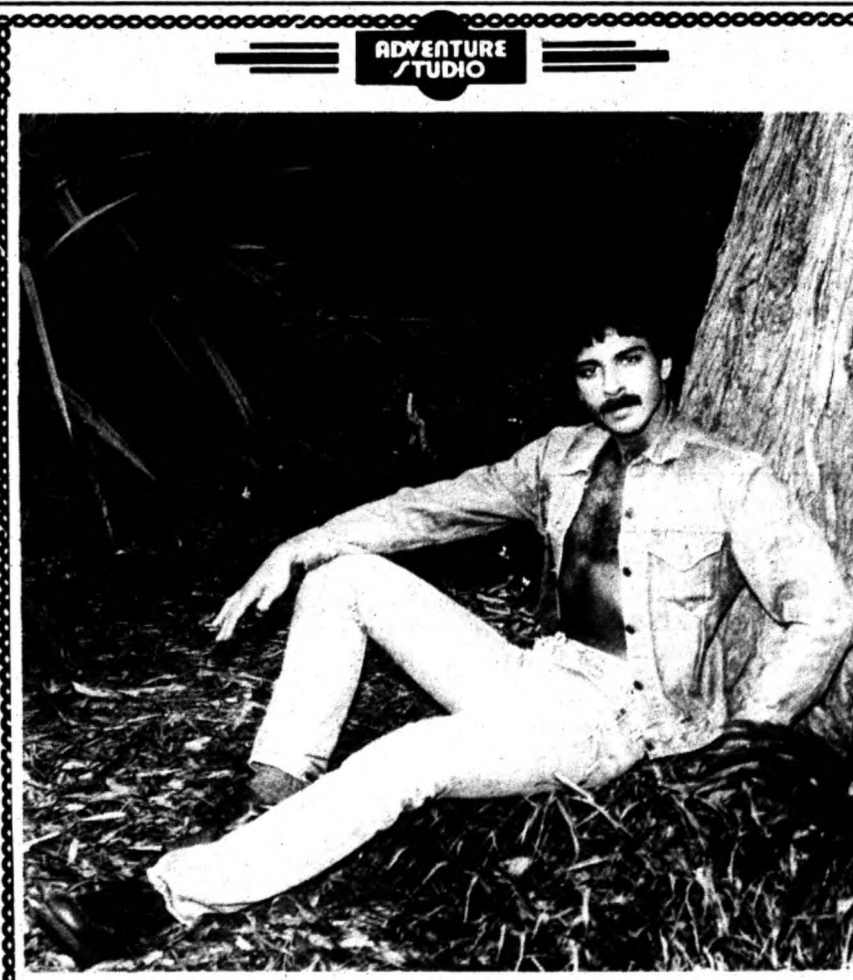

Later I learned that one of the girls (supposedly Maria's friend) was in the room with Marlene during the conversation. When Marlene had hung up she turned to this girl. "You told me some bad things about Dean. But he sounds like a gentleman. Why did you lie to me about him?"

**DEAN:** Let's say we were over a temporary hump. Maria and I were happy for a while, but the cards were really stacked against us. We were scheduled for some rocky times ahead.

A letter with a financial account of the Dade County Coalition was sent to this newspaper by an unknown source. The figures were staggering to say the least. Jim Foster, of the Alice B. Toklas Memorial Democratic Club, who was in Dade County less than five weeks, received a total of \$5,699.00 cash, PLUS, his transportation, meals and room. Another San Francisco person, one associated with past campaigns of Sheriff Richard Hongisto, a Clint Reilly, received \$3,360 PLUS his travel, room, and meals. Reilly is also a member of the Alice B. Toklas Memorial Democratic Club. The ADVOCATE (Liberation Publications, Inc.) received a nice of money for promotion...\$7,308.00 so David B. Goodstein's ADVOCATE was not so charitable, as were the other newspapers which gave full page ads for the Dade County Coalition...something which this publication warned others not to do...as we had a few questions about the operations...now, with this report, we have had them answered quite clearly. VOLUNTEERS are evidently quite scarce in many sectors of the gay community...and few if any of the "pros" like Foster will do much of anything without getting paid for.

# Will The Genuine Bishop Please Stand Up?



The erratic "Bishop" of Los Angeles...Michael Itkin!

MOST OF THEM ARE GAY...BUT NOT ALL! BUT THEY ALL CLAIM TO BE TRUE AND APOSTOLIC SUCCESSORS TO THE POPE! Bill collectors are after many of them...others are having fun "playing church"...some like to send bogus packages through the mails! "Will the Genuine Bishop(s) please stand up?"

Lester Kinsolving, nationally syndicated columnist for the Washington Post whose column runs in the SF Progress has wrote several articles on the strange behavior of "Father" Lawrence Smith



"Father" Lawrence Gerard, or Larry Smith, recently convicted of the California Penal Code Section 288, dealing with sex with children...he likes to send bogus packages and mail and the postal authorities are after him.

Gerard. According to the nationally recognized Right Reverend Zaborowski, who is director of St. Gregory's Maravite Old Catholic Church/Monastery in Wyandotte, Michigan...all of the above are not real "fathers", "brothers" or "bishops" but merely frauds, with none having Apostolic succession.

Bishop Zaborowski is a nationally acknowledged expert on the old Catholic Churches in America and elsewhere. He has extensive files and libraries on the subject. Recently Bishop Zaborowski and others were the victim of a "criminal" prank which was played by "Father" Lawrence

Gerard Smith, 65 Vicksburg Street. Originally the "criminal prank" was thought to have been committed by a Brother Paul B., but, he appears to have been cleared.

"Father" Gerard sent packages, allegedly, to various clerics, having had a rubber stamp made with another's name on it, which is a felony fraud, and sent garbage to the various clerics about the country. They were all people whom "Father" Gerard did not particularly care for. Postal authorities and the Alameda County Probation Department have been notified on this subject. Action is pending the outcome of the investigation.

"Father" Lawrence, after his conviction on the 15 year old boy, sought a passport to leave the country to journey to Italy to study at a monastery, but was denied a passport.

These "old Catholic Church" "priests" all battle (so to speak) with one another to tremendous proportions. Some of the Old Catholic Church priests have made good here in San Francisco, and have nothing to do with the "play-priests". A good example of a spiritual person is Bishop Nazarin and his associate, Father Phillip Clifton, a friend of the late Robert Hillsborough. They both are highly spiritual persons, who practice the Catholic faith regularly, and are a credit to any denomination.

The opposite examples of the above two priests would be "Father" Wayne Price who was ordained by "Bishop" Itkin. Price has left a string of bills unpaid behind him. A trait which is found in several like him.

Another "Old Catholic Church" priest, who wormed his way into the County Jail of Sheriff Richard Hongisto, was "Father" Bob Richards, also known as Robert Tato.

He took off from a Neighborhood Legal Project where he had been working, and it appears with things not belonging to him. The irony of it is that several weeks later, an attorney in New York called San Francisco trying to find Tato or Richards, to inform him that he had come into a sizeable inheritance.

IS THE OLD CATHOLIC CHURCH VALID?

The answer to that is not yes or no! It depends upon the congregation, and the method of operation. Valid orders can only come through the Maravite order, and only a handful, according to Bishop Zaborowski, have valid Maravite orders. The Old Catholic Church was formed at Utrecht, after many priests felt the Pope had gone too far in declaring his infallibility and declaring "Mary the mother of God" and that you could pray to Mary instead of Christ, for forgiveness of sins.

Several Old Catholic Church groups in America, are doing tremendous works for the good of all people. They lend great support to the poor and needy in our midst.

Bishop Zaborowski of Wyandotte is one of those, and there are numerous others, who we will mention in later issues of the SF CRUSADER. In fact, we hope to have a bio of Bishop Zaborowski in the next issue of the paper.

Meanwhile, the games go on, and the only one really getting anything out of all of this, is the religious supply stores which sell the clerical drag to numerous of the well-meaning, but sometimes phony "priests".

Is the "priest" you know for real? A good way to find out is watch them, and see their actions, then ye shall know them by their deeds.

Beware.....there are many imitators in life!

# SEBASTIANE

SEBASTIANE is a new film from London England, done by Derek Jarman. It is done in Latin, with English subtitles. The color, as well as the cinematography are superb. Most of the film was shot in Sardinia, with the remainder being done in Jarman's studio in London. Most who have seen the film agree that it is the most perfect film done since Jean Cocteau's BEAUTY AND THE BEAST. Perfection is something really rare in films, but SEBASTIANE comes closer to it than any film shown in recent years in America. SEBASTIANE has not yet come to the United States, even tho it is soon to be shown in Canada.

The man who plays Sebastiane is extremely handsome, and it, SEBASTIANE deals with the months leading up to the martyrdom of Saint Sebastiane. The opening sequence is set in 303, and establishes Sebastiane as captain of the Emperor's guard and his "favorite". They kiss with the kiss of brotherly love but Sebastiane objects when the Emperor Diocletian orders the brutal death of a boy. The Emperor strips him of his rank and banishes him to service in a lonely outpost, where eight soldiers and their captain all drill endlessly to fill in time.

Here interactions occur...Adrian and Anthony fall in love, Severus the Captain is smitten with Sebastiane's beauty. Max, a syphalytic "swinger", mocks the youth and homo-erotic tendencies of the "boys" and he can't wait to get back to Rome and the ladies of the evening. The natural, child-like playful love of Adrian and Anthony takes center stage in the film for some time, and due to their love for one another, the learing evil Severus's lust grows for Sebastiane.

But, Sebastiane is a mystic. His love for GOD draws him into solitary communion with the Creator through water, sunlight, rock and sea. He ignores the lusting of Severus and after a while, refuses to take part in unnecessary fighting. He is punished for this, at first for insubordination and later for his rejection of the lust of Severus for Sebastiane's body. Sebastiane endures all punishment meekly, turning the other cheek, and he turns more and more to GOD. His love for the Creator grows with each punishment imposed upon him, and he fiercely detaches himself from worldly pre-occupation. His inner strength attracts the handsome Justin, who also rebels against Severus and who is finally castrated for his "Christian-loving".

Taunted beyond all endurance, Serveus, drunk, promises to love Sebastiane, who rebels against the advances of the drunken captain. Finally the captain sentences him to death and each soldier is obliged to shoot one arrow into his body.

The men and lads in the film are handsome, they carry themselves well, and with great enthusiasm. This is no second-rate production. It is the finest quality film that you will see on the subject of homoerotic art and homoerotic love. It treats homosexual love naturally and humane. It is not a gay film in the accepted sense, but, naturally people with homoerotic inclinations will make up the major portion of the audience. To some degree this is a pity as it does give equal weight to Sebastiane's sanctity as it does to Severus's lust and the love of Adrian and Anthony. By implication, it stands for love over lust (hooray), and in that, it is truly moral.

Adrian and Anthony are, in their own way, as beautiful as Sebastiane. Their love is some how of the same order. Severus's lust is ugly because it treats "the other" in this case, a most unresponsive mystic, as a sex object.

Sebastiane and his GOD, Anthony and his Adrian, both pairs of lovers are moving towards a wholeness and it is a privilege to be allowed to watch them.

This is not a film of "bed and roses" or a "land of milk and honey". There are moments of ugliness and violence which will make tears come to your eyes. The love scenes, the beauty of the land in which it was made will all make you leave the theatre feeling that all is not wrong with the world, and that right will triumph over wrong and that the John Briggs and Anita Bryants and their supporters will in some way, allow us to live in peace. We cannot recommend this film highly enough. We hope to see it sometime in the near future at the NOB HILL CINEMA.





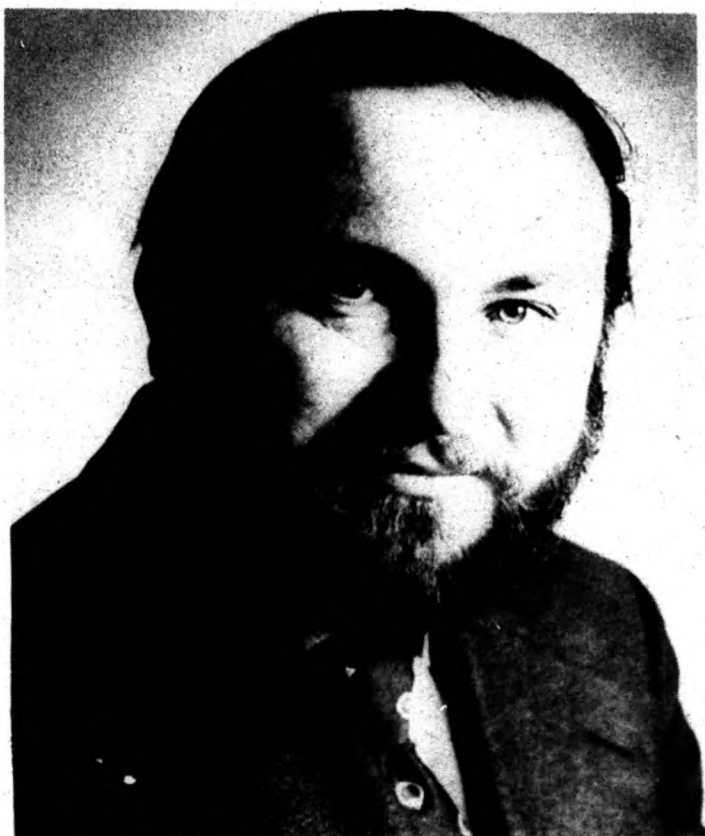

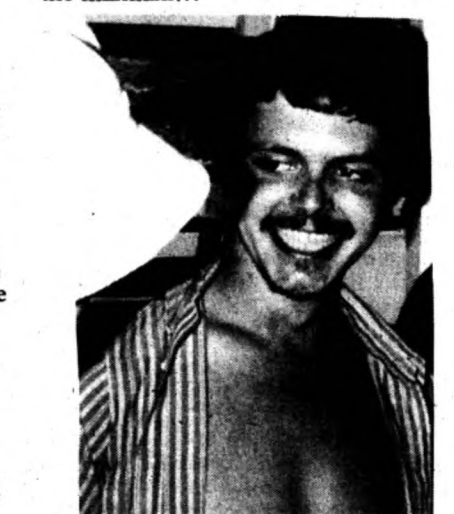

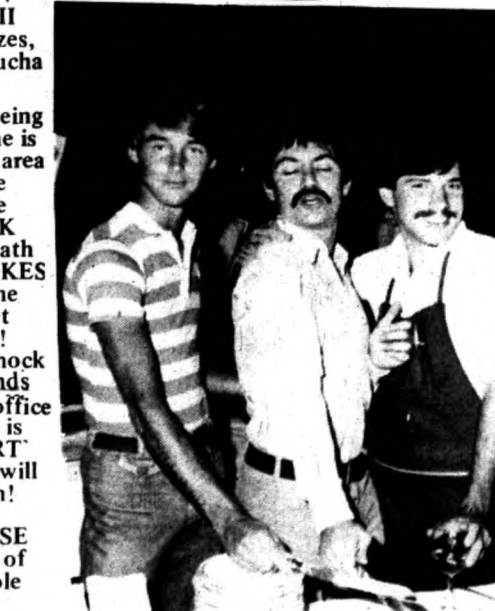
