The Rt. Reverend C. Kilmer Myers, Bishop of the protestant Episcopal Church of California, spoke out loudly on Sunday September 3rd in a sermon at the Grace Cathedral concerning State Senator John Brigg's Prop6.

g's Prop6. "I am profoundly concerned about the erosion of the personal rights of men and women of gay sexual orientation."

"I am profoundly concerned with the threats to their rights posed by the Briggs Initiative, Proposition 6, the net effect of which would be the firing of all homosexual teachers.

Bishop Myers siad that the initiative's language is so vague that even a "straight" teacher could be fired for "merely advising a student with possible homosexual tendencies to seek the aid of a therapist." "One cannot forget, that in our generation, the Hitler program of human extermination began with homosexuals."

"One wonders if the initiative passes who will be the next—the psychiatrists, the psychologists, the clergy

Bishop Myers continued, "I am compelled to oppose any law which would have the effect of dehumanizing men and women or imperling their responsible freedom.

The Bishop of all California protestant Episcopalians continued, saying, on singer Anita Bryant, that "A veritable witch hunt has begun and we ignore it at our peril."

ignore it at our peril." He added that "The record of the church in this regard is by no means clean. It is, in fact, deeply stained with the blood of executed homosexuals."

The Bishop said that he considered the Briggs measure "a very serious issue and a matter of immediate concern."


Bishop Myers thus becomes the highest ranking churchman in America to take a stand against the actions of Anita Bryant and John Briggs and their likes. As the Bishop stated, it could become a matter of the clergy being voted on next, to ban them from contact with homosexuals.

Attorney B.J. Beckwith, well known gay trial lawyer, who seldom loses in his sex case battles with the police, stated that he was "pleased at the interest of the Church and Bishop Myers", and stated that in his opinion that should the Briggs Proposition 6 pass, that a statewide initiative in 1980 to repeal the Brown consenting adults sexual legislation is more than possible.

Other gay actitivests sopke out quite loudly in approval of the sermon by Bishop C. Kilmer Myers, most them expressing surprise that he spoke out at all on this critical issue.

Already one death can be attributed to the Briggs measure, that of Jack Lera, the room-mate and former lover of Supervisor Harvey Milk who "feared the persecution" that was going to come down on gay people. He took his own life on Monday August 28th while the first elected gay Supervisor was at a meeting. A great tragedy and sorrow which the gay community shares with Supervisor Milk and Lera's family in Fresno. It is hoped that Bishop Myers sermon would inspire those homosexuals



THE COMING SEASON

Summer is over, school, fall and sales of season tickets are upon us from two of our three major theatrical producers: American Conservatory Theatre, Best of • Broadway, and Civic Light Opera. Tak-ing them alphebetically........

ACT, 771-3880 for info.....fresh from this summer's triumphal tour of Japan & Hawaii, is offering their largest season ever, ten plays including the now tradi-tional "CHRISTMAS CAROL", and revivals of last seasons two biggest success-es, "THE CIRCLE.. and "HOTEL PARA DISO". The seven new productions are by Shakespeare, Shaw, Turgenev, O'Niell Coward, Durrenmatt and the west coast premiere of a new play by Langford Wil- • son (HOT'L BALTIMORE' HOME FREE THE MADNESS OF LDAY BRIGHT). Certainly an impressive list of authors but the plays themselves are more impressive in that the Company is not presenting the usually done best known ones, but is giving us a chance to see plays we rarely otherwise could view.

The season at ACT opens in October with "le based upon "Kismet". three plays coming in alittle over two weeks: "A WINTERS TALE", the last • EARTHA KITT will be opening of Shakespeare's major plays and the next to last he wrote, then Turgenev's "A MONTH IN' THE COUNTRY" and then Eugene O'Neills, "AH WILDERNESS" his only comedy and a wonderfully poig-nent look at youth in what now seems a far simpler time. THE CIRCLE and the CHRISTMAS CAROL fill out the fall. George Bernanrd Shaw's HEARTBREAK HOUSE, a fantasy in the Russian mann-HOUSE, a fantasy in the Russian mann-er on English themes., starts the new year followed by Wilson's THE FIFTH OF JULY a month later, which is billed as a comedy/drama about Berkeley activists of the sixties who meet today and discuss their radical youth. Then comes Durren-matt's modern classic, THE VISIT, about the richest woman in the world and her particular ideas of revenge, shortly follow -ed by Noel Coward's HAYFEVER, a hilarious comedy about a not-so-restful weekend in the country. The season will weekend in the country. The season will close with the revival of the classic Fren-ch farce, HOTEL PARADISO.

In it's early days, ACT received little but unbounded praise; no it might-quite legi-timately feel like a prophet " in his own country". Critics from other cities both praise the Company and envy San Fran-cisco for having it, but it seems the "in" thing with many local reviewers to find fault, if not with the productions them-selves, then with the choices of this season,

scott Galager due to a hassie with Equity! All three sing and dance with verve if not great polish and offer a lively eve-ning's enjoyment. Verling songs hold up well over more than sixty-five years and wisely the selection is not limited to just his best known hits but is intersparsed with many of his locer known tonse A must for Berlin lovers, IN REVUE is a lively and fast paced show and it will be interesting to see how long it will last since local audiences are not noted for enthu usiastic support of small revues. The really great, STARTING HERE, START-ING NOW didn't last long; I hope that IN REVUE does.

Kaussen owns 29 buildings in San Francisco and apparently does as litt le as possible to uplift them, taking money and putting little back into the upkeep of the buildings, which led to the 805 Leavenworth rental strike. Kaussen now has over 100,000 rental units worldwide, with some of them being the greatest slum buildings in all of the world, particularly those he has in England. GAYS CAUGHT IN Gay Teacher Held on Three Sex Charges with 15 Year Old

Anthony Gale, 35 year old Oakland school teacher who lives in San Francisco on Haight Street, was taken into Investigative Custody and held on \$40,000 bail on Friday September 1 in Oakland on three counts of alleged oral copulation of a 15 year old boy in his class.

m his class. The 15 year old is but one of five students in Gale's class, as they are all deaf and Gale himself is legally deaf. Gale, a tall, frail looking man who looks more like 23 than his 35 years was held in Oakland City Jail all of the Labor Day weekend

Gale is one of thefounders of the gay Rainbow Society for the deaf/mutes but over the weekend rejected the gay legal help he sought earlier and is reportedly seeking a "straight" lawyer in this most sensitive case. Jim Foster, founder of the Alice B. Tok--as Democratic Club, told the Crusader that he believes this practice of voting in more than one CDC club to be a violation of the CDC Membership Charter. Wilhelm said that he was making an offi-cial protest to the State Chair of the CDC Ms. Wally Alberston and to other CDC officials about this practice.

officials about this practice. One well known gay Democrat has been voting in six different Democratic clubs, two of which are gay oriented. The Alice B. Toklas Democratic Club is the wealthiest of the gay Democratic Club groups here of which there are three; the Minutemen Democratic Club; Alice B. n a move that Chief of Police Charles Gain kept as quiet as he could, the Police Comm-unity Relations Unit was disbanded. The Police Community Relations Unit (PCR) was formed by former Chief of Police Tom Cahill, a great Irish Chief of Police and was headed up first by Lt. Dante Androtti. Androtti's term as head of PCR was limted, but, he left his mark on the Department and on the City of San Francisco through the CR.

Chief Cahill felt that closer and informal

contact was needed between the Police and beteen the minority communiticontact was needed between the Police and beteen the minority communiti-es, such as the black, chicano, and gays. Rodney Williams a Patrolman rose to become the head of the Unit, and over the objections of many, was nearly promoted to a special rank in the Department which would have made him right under Gain. Williams, a *black*, did not enjoy support from the gay community which could have given him the rank that he sought. He was re-placed by Sgt. Henry Williams and later by the last commander of the Unity Sgt. Troy Dangerfield, who is entremely popular with the gay community. The appointment of a gay liason to the gay community in 1965 by Chief of Police Cahill in the person of Officer Elliott Blackstone, helped bring gays to the exhalted political position they now enjoy. the exhalted political position they now enjoy. Too many gays want to for-get Blackstone it is felt and supported Gain as a result, in his effort disband the badly needed Unit.

Blackstone was the one who orginated the gays vs. police annual softball games which has changed to become gays & straights vs. police in the last

Gain's Public Relations Officer, Michael O'Toole has been less than cooperative in this matter as well as others, and as a restul of the disbandment of the Unit, many minorities who could have their problem PCR Unit are now being arrested, beaten and mistreated by the Police. Gain through his PR man, O'Toole denies all of this. O'Toole is very very apathetic about his job which has led to a clamor for his removal, for without a proper person in this post, there is no direct contact with the Chief of Police without the PCR Unit.

Deputy Chief of Police Jerimiah Taylor has told the CRUSADER that there is now a man at each District station who is supposed to deal with community problems, but it has been pointed out to the Deputy Chief and the Chief that there are no policeofficers who appear willing to work with the gay community, with the possible exception of Officer Mike Perra of the Northern Station. Perra's contact with the gay community is very very limited. Gain has said that the Unit will never be re-activated during his reign as the Chief of Police, as a result, there is a growing clamor for either his removal or else the revival of the PCR, in community meetings who are letting the Members of the Board of Supervisors and the Office of the Mayor know of this outrage against police and community relations. How long Gain and his PR man O'Toole will continue to ignore the problem-

s of the community is unknown, but as more and more people are arrested, with little or no cause, all because of the lack of communication between the Police Department and the community, it is obvious that Chief Gain's days a Chief of Police are numbered.

The Vice Unit head, Captain George Emil said that the disbandment of the PCR Unit is the best thing to hit the SFPD in years. This alone is reason enough to call for it's revival, as Captain Emil is a very dangerous person.


Pope John Paul

Pope John Paul I was "crowned"/"consecrated" in simp eremonies at the Vatican on Sunday September 3rd 1978. t was a history making event, as the new Pope shunned the spectacular pomp and pagentry of 15 Centuries of his prede-cessors. 
District Attorney cracks Down on gays! Reports of marital Rift!

COLUMNIST "HOLLYWOOD" by LEE RAYMOND

Dear Readers I'm sorry I couldn't be

Dear Readers.....I'm sorry I couldn't be with you last issue, but negotiations were in progress for me to play a major role in an up-coming Hollywood film..... which I turned down, it was the part of the "Lollypop" in the remake of the "Good Ship Lollypop".....I figured if I were to play an all-day sucker, I was going to chose the one who.....er, well, you know what I mean. However, I may be going back to "tinsel town" to film be going back to "tinsel town" to film the mod version of "Snow White and the the mod version of "Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs", and with 7 young men around me plus riding into the sunset on a big STEED with a big STUD (and who could pass that up?) I may never come back. But enough of that!!!!!! If you have been following my columns, you know I've been writing about fema-le stars, well for this issue, I decided to switch to the Hollywood grantleman

and nobody fits that description better than Claude Rains.

CLAUDE RAINS must be reconed amoor the finest actors who ever played in films, he has made a score or so of most enjoyable movies during the 1930's and '40's, and they, and weaker efforts, all benefited from his presence. He has a fine speaking voice, like honey with abit of gravel in it, and that neatly typed him as the most suave and sarcastic of

of gravel in it, and that neatly typed him as the most suave and sarcastic of villans, very neat, and polished, with a scornful right eyebrow. He encompassed almost every sort of worldly wickedness, though he tended to be artistic rather than executive; and he could go to the sympathetic line with ease and authority His effectiveness depended on his respo-nse to his material; he could ham when he felt like it but he was never lazy and he felt like it, but he was never lazy and never uninteresting. Like Paul Muni, he gave each character a special touch, dis-tinguished each from the other. The essence of a good actor. He was not phy-sically shaped to be a Hollywood leading man, but producers recognized his worth to the extent that he did get star parts

and star billing. He was born in London, November 10th He was born in London, November 10th 1889 into a poor family, and his father Fredrick Wm. Raines was an actor, pro-ducer and director in silent movies and struggled all his life for success. At age 9, William Claude was sent to Kent to live with his grandparents, and ran away from school which he loathed, and back to London he went where he met a boy who eng in a choir. The boy invited who sang in a choir. The boy invited William Claude, who had a good soprano

voice, to try out and he was accepted. Not too long after his choir master was er's general manager again playing occass -ional parts. He then returned to Britan ional parts. He then returned to Britan to join the Army and served until 1919... when he appeared in "Uncle Ned" in Henry Ainley's company. This was the mile stone that began to make a name for him in London. He married again..... just for a short-time in 1920 to Marie Hemingway, although his marriage did not go well, his career was going great. He did an admired, "Government Inspec-tor" and notably at the Everyman in Shaw Dubedat in "The Doctor Delimma"as Napoleon in "The Man of Destiny" as Dick in "The Devil's Disciple". He was seldom out of work, and by day he taught at the Royal Academy of Drama-tic Arts(John Gielgud speaks warmly of

taught at the Royal Academy of Januar tic Arts (John Gielgud speaks warmly of him as a teacher in his memoir "Early Stages") He met Beatrix Thomson in one of the acting classes he taught, she

got the silver medal for most talented actress of 1922, and in 1924 she added the name of Rains to monogram. In 1926 Mr. Rains a-companied his wife Beatrix to New York where she starred in "The Constant Nymph" in which he took a small role, but later took on the male lead in the U.S. tour. He settled in the U.S. and was soon a respected Broad-way name in "The Apple Cart", "And So To Bed", "The Man Who Reclaimed His Head" and "The Good Earth" to mention but a few! He was screen-tested but was consider-ed unlikely film material, however, James Whale saw the test and thought him suitable for his version of H.G. Well's "The Invisible Man". The Part was originally offerred to Boris Korloff who refused it because the ch-afacter isn't seen till the end of the movie. The success of the movie made Rains a film name, and after one more Broadway show,

name, and after one more Broadway show, he was a demand in Hollywood.

Two years after his film debut, he and Bea-trix divorced April 8, '35 and the next day he married Frances Propper whom he knew from the Theatre Guild. He bought a farm in Pennsylvannia where they lived until the divorce of 1956. His only child, Jennifer, was born January 24 '38. Shortly after sett-ling down on the farm, Warner Brothers sign-ed him to a long term contract beginning an association which seems to have been happier than that of other top Warner stars. He was mostly the heavy......but in a widely contras -ting range of pictures, ; Anthony Adverse as the domineering father, Hearts Divided as Napoleon, Stolen Holiday as a crooked finan-cier, They Made Me A Criminal as a relentle-ss detective, Juarez as Napoleon III, etc, etc. And then came "Mr. Smith Goes To Washing -ton" for which he won his first Oscar nomi-nation as the most corrupt of Senators. The Oscar for that year for supporting actor sent to Thomas Mitchell for "Stagecoach", he was also nominated for supporting actor for his work in Casablanca.....the award that year sent to Van Heflin for "Johnny Eager". 'in '42. He received his third nomination for "Mr. Skeffinton" that was '44. But Barry Fitzgerald won it that year Two years after his film debut, he and Bea

in '42. He received his third nomination for "Mr. Skeffinton" that was '44. But Barry Fitzgerald won it that year.
His fourth nomination was for "Notorious" but Harold Russell, the quadruple amputee, got it for "The Best Years of Uour Lives"...... but I believe he received it more for sympath -y than merit. Rains certainly did deserve to get an Oscar to go along with his "Toni" and other acting awards. Who could ever forget him in such hits as......"Now Voyager"....... Kings Row......and the very best version of the "Phantom of the Opera"? I could go on and on listing his fine work but all one has to 0 do is mention his name and one word comes to mind....talent! Because of the changing times and scripts not being what they used voice, to try out and he was accepted. Not too long after his choir master was to provide some boys for a crowd scene in "Nell of Old Drury" at the Haymarketit was an experience which convinced him that he was going to be an actor. In 1911, he got a part in "The Gods of the Mountain" and later that year began an Australian tour of the "Blue Bird" as stage manager and played small parts. It was in 1913 he married for the first time and this time it was for a short time to Isabel Jeans, a British stage actress. For the next few years he was Granville-Bark er's general manager again playing occass

and his rainity moved to bacoma, new manp 6 shire.
Aging, and now white-haired, he was still active, he played with Rock Hudson in "This - Earth Is Mine" and a few minor parts in Italy and then brought distinction to small parts in "Lawrence of Arabia" and "Twilight of Honor". His last movie was in 1965, "The Greatest Story Ever Told" and his last acting appearance was at the Westport Country Playhouse in "So Much of Earth, So Much of Heaven" in 1965. May 30 th, 1967 the world lost a great actor, as Mr. Claude Rains died of intestinal hemorrage.
He was a very under-estimated actor and he is much missed by those who really appreciated good acting.




The Army is a Drag!
