In the process of pouring over my highly disorganized notes, I real ized that what I want to send home is everything--and in neariy the next breath, I knew it was entirely possible. The transcripts of th. Tribunal are now being copied in Brussels, and two women are editin a book which will include everything. They plan to flimish by th first of May. (When it will be available I'm not sure.) What I wan to do is collect all, the lesbian testimonies from the conference an try to make sense of my impressions and put them together with any thing else I can find here (and there is a lot).

At least $40 \%$ of the women at the Tribunal (that's $2,000+90$ alto gether, from $30 t$ countries) were Lesbians. That is, were open y, joyously Lesbian--meeting everyday at lunchtime to discuss strategy many wearing signs, "I'm a Lesbian--How about youp" Considering tha most women must stay in the closet--even at such a meeting--it i wonderfully impossible to say just how many Lesbians (feminist les bians: ) were there altogether. Most simply wore the unmistakeabl smiles of proud acceptance and freedom.
"Oppression of Iesbians" was officially delegated to Sunday, the las day of "testimonies." Everything wes, however, thoroughly mixed $u$ long beforehand. On Thursday, about 250 gay women met for the firs time. Unanimously, We will not be relegated to a toplc .. Lesbian are particularly oppressed in every form of crime committed agains women!" We decided to meet every day, and did, We made signs, w shared experiences, and gave support; we suffered agonies over trans. lation and prepared a statement to the Mribunal at large. On Satur day, some $300+$ Lesbians flooded the podium, the stairs, the entir front of the hall, singing an absuxdly wonderful song with a millior verses and a chorus of "Lesbiant Lesbiant Lesbiant" after each, Anr our statement WE ARE HEREI was read.

Needless to say, some women squirmed in their seats, some were indig. nant--but not many. The vast majonity was wishing for the freedom to join in.

On Sunday, as originally scheduled, testimontes were given, A Nor. weigen woman first read her testimony. Discrimination there is abso Iute. Most Lesbians are wives and mothers who would be forced to ab andon their homes and children to come out. Admitted Lesbians ar isolated in prisons, forcibly raped in psychiatric hospitals, art given no protection from violence under the law. Her testimony was personal and bitter.

Women from the Lesbian Action Center in West Berlin described th yellow press tactics of their country. Two women, Judy Anderson anc Marion Thns, were convicted for the murder of Inns husband--but thed were actually tried for the public exploitation of their "perversion.

In England, "Wages Due Lesbians" proposes a strategy of Lesbians de. manding wages for housework. I don't quite follow that one, but it is a strong Marxist group in London.

The pros come in the form ads taken out in some of tl "straightex" publications by ou collective power and light co panies. Basically, they're out placate our worst fears, and th are very successful at it. I : skimming through an old Newswe and came-across an ad which re "Why shouldn't I be concerr with Nuclear Power Plants?"; went on to explain that we real have NOTHING to worry about (th) have it well under control:ddd! There are no PROVEN dangers radiation, explosion, leakage waste products (plutonium), etc Profect Survival (located in Palo Alto) disagrees with the co cept of "safe" nuclear plants. They contend that the emergency sy tems in these plants have never been fully tested (scale models test have flunked 6 times out of 6). Storage leakage is another sore poi: with Project Survival. After 30 years, the storage tanks begin leak plutonium into the ground, contaminating the earth we live on a: lasting approximately 250,000 years. And the list goes on and o There must be some safeguards against nuclear disasters occurring our planet; alternative means of harnassing power must be explored.

We have not been given enough information on the "shortcomings: of these plants and it's about time we get that information.

On June 8 there will be an election held; on the ballot will a nuclear initiative---Proposition 15. Registration closes May 9. strongly urge you to register and vote Yes on that proposition.
